CCC's Teach Out Process

Designed to ensure students who have made progress on discontinued awards have a reasonable opportunity to complete before the College completely ends offering courses/support.

IR reviews the award requirements and compares student records for successful completion of 50 percent or more of each award.

The College reaches out to qualifying students to ask if they have a desire to complete the award. If they do, a plan for the student is put together for the student to earn the award.
