SUBJECT: Panorama Education Tool - Early Warning System

The Student Services Department is requesting to renew our contract for the Panorama Education online tool for the 2026-2027 school year. As defined in Utah State Statute 53F-4-207, schools need a tool that integrates criteria for early warning indicators as part of a student profile to allow teachers and schools to easily identify a student who may be in need of intervention and to assist school districts and individual school to use the resource to analyze for planning, evaluating, and enhancing programs. Panorama meets the code definition of an Early Warning System. The Utah State Board of Education has approved Panorama Education as the provider for our statewide Early Warning System. The state will subsidize 50% of the annual cost if an LEA chooses Panorama as its Early Warning System. Districts are billed 100% of the price by the vendor. USBE will distribute 50% of that cost to the district directly via the Grants Management System each October.

The total purchase price is \$192,000. The cost for the district is \$96,000. The purchase price includes annual licenses for each school, training for implementation and use of the online platform, reporting tools, and alignment with USBE statutory requirements. Schools provide the majority of the funds through designated allocations based on student enrollment.
