Topic: Hallsville ISD Education Foundation Donation

Background and Rationale:

The **Hallsville ISD Education Foundation** is proud to present this year's donation to Hallsville ISD. Because of the generosity of our community, we were able to make a significant investment in our students and educators in 2026.

This year, we funded:

- **22 Innovative Grants** totaling **\$58,464.59**
- **20 Mini Grants** totaling **\$7,681.34**

These grants, totaling **\$66,145.93**, will be deposited into the district's general fund so that awarded grant items may be purchased and implemented in classrooms across the district.

In addition, the Foundation provided funding for scholarships, teacher recognition, campus support, and student celebrations:

\$58,464.59 – Innovative Grants

\$7,681.34 – Mini Grants

\$3,350.00 – Cash Sponsorship Grants (5 at \$250 and 14 at \$150)

\$1,000.00 – District Teachers of the Year (\$500 each)

\$800.00 – Campus Teachers of the Year (\$200 each)

\$1,200.00 – Campus Representatives (\$200 each)

\$2,000.00 – Dual Credit Scholarship Funding

\$1,500.00 – Academic Scholarship

\$1,500.00 – CTE Scholarship

\$1,000.00 – New Teacher Surprise Grants (\$100 each)

\$3,000.00 – Convocation Teacher Surprise Grants (\$100 each)

\$14,945.50 – Campus Grants

\$3,500.00 – Top 10% Ceremony
