Teaching & Learning School Board Report *for* July 9, 2026

Summer Programs

The two week Migrant Program at Molalla Elementary ended on June 25th. Participants were able to work on core academics as well as intensive language support to build confidence and proficiency before the new school year begins.

A four week Elementary Summer School Enrichment Program began July 6th: Clarkes and Mulino students will NOT be attending Mulino for the summer program. Due to unforeseen construction at Mulino Elementary during July, the Mulino summer program is now being relocated to Molalla Elementary to ensure student safety. MES and Rural Dell students will be attending MES for the summer program. In addition there will be a four week Middle School Summer Program held at MES due to the construction at the middle school.

The summer program serves approximately 284 K-8 students, supported by a dedicated team of 31 staff members. The curriculum delivers a robust core academic foundation in literacy and mathematics, seamlessly blended with project-based learning and enrichment activities. Ultimately, the program cultivates an engaging, collaborative environment where students experience a deep sense of belonging while having fun. The high school will also run a credit recovery program during the month of July.

Kindergarten Camp

Kindergarten Camps will again happen at all of our elementaries in August. Starting dates for each building program varies but all will have a 30 hour program. The purpose of the camp is to give Kinders a head start on routines, familiarity with the building and staff and most importantly getting them excited for the first day of Kindergarten. Kindergarten Camp is funded by our State Summer Learning Grant.
