Senate Bill 571



Expanded “Do Not Hire” Registry

Extends background check and misconduct reporting requirements to previously unvetted groups on campus, including volunteers, third-party service providers, and contractors.



Strict Timelines

Requires principals to report educator misconduct to superintendents within 48 hours. Superintendents must then report these allegations through the TEA portal within 48 hours.



Expanded Definitions

Broadens the definition of abuse and misconduct to include inappropriate boundary violations, sexual conduct, and romantic relationships with students.



Criminal Penalties

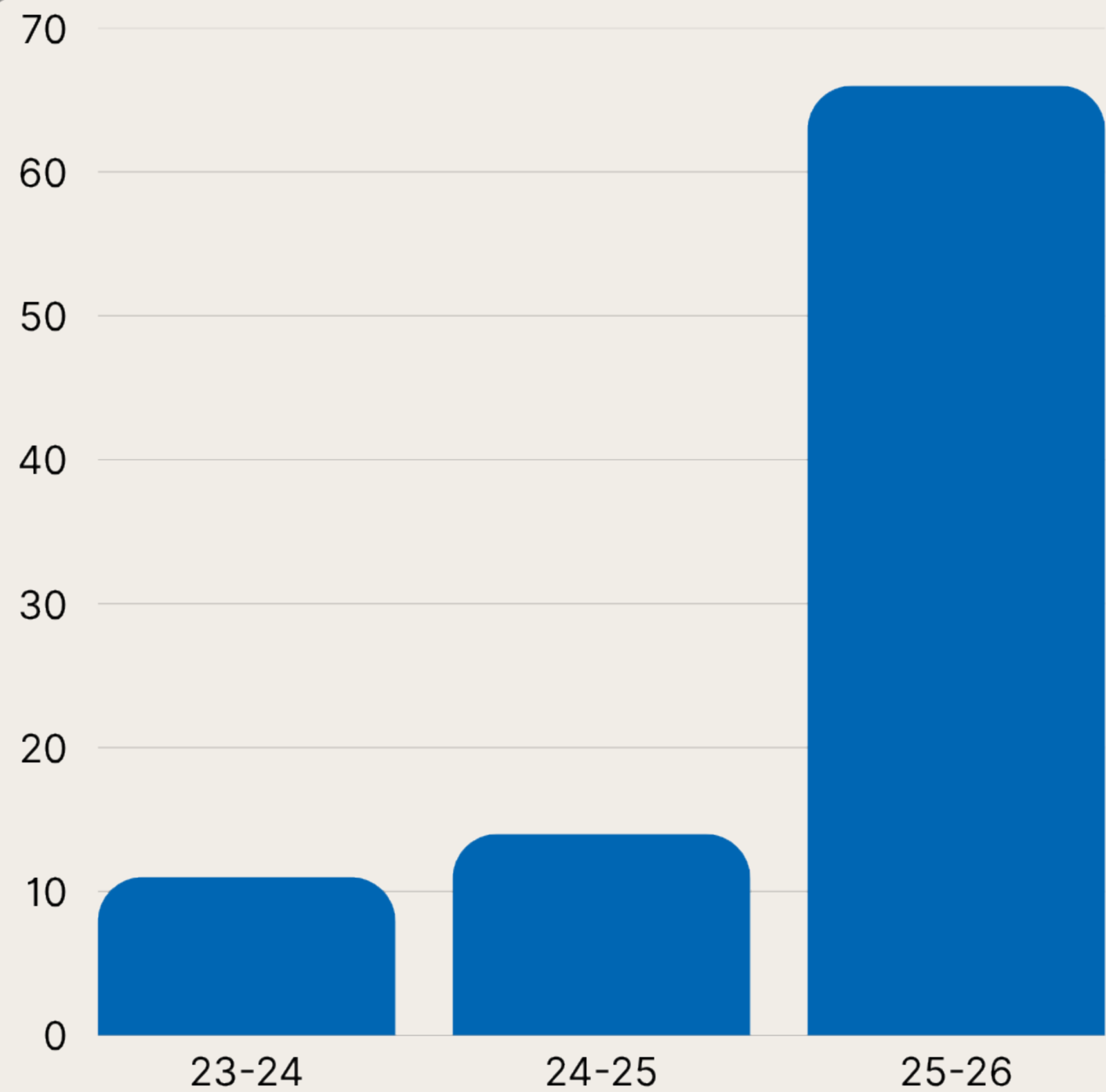
Increases criminal penalties for superintendents and school leaders who fail to report misconduct to shield perpetrators.



Employment Affidavits

Expands the requirement for pre-employment and pre-service affidavits for anyone seeking an educational role in the state.

Denton ISD SBEC Reports

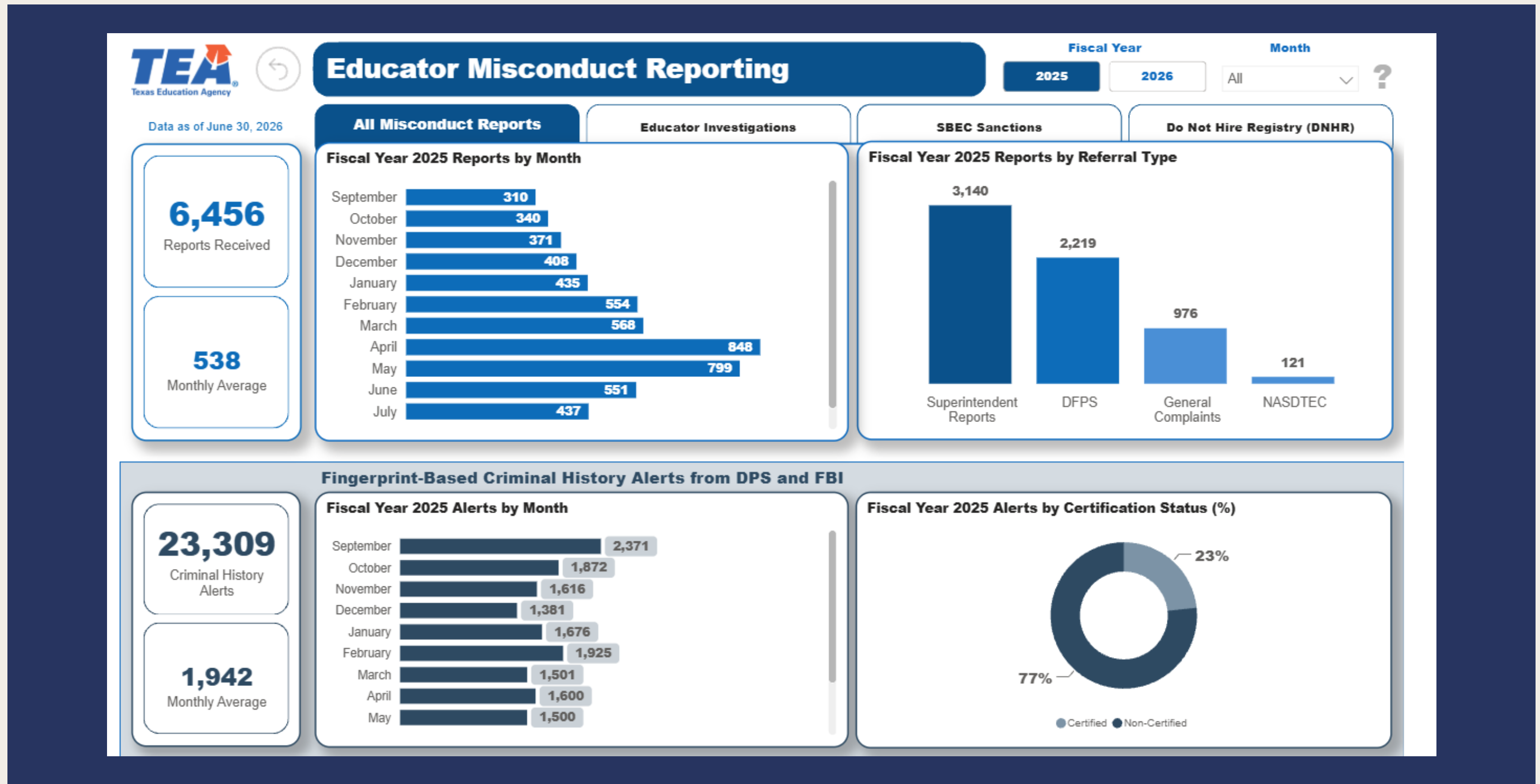


- **SBEC reports increased from 11 in 2023-24 to 66 in 2025-26, a 6x increase in two years.**
- **This increase reflects a change in what must be reported under new legislation, not a change in campus conduct or safety trends. The 371% jump in filings corresponds to the expanded reporting mandate, not a rise in incidents.**

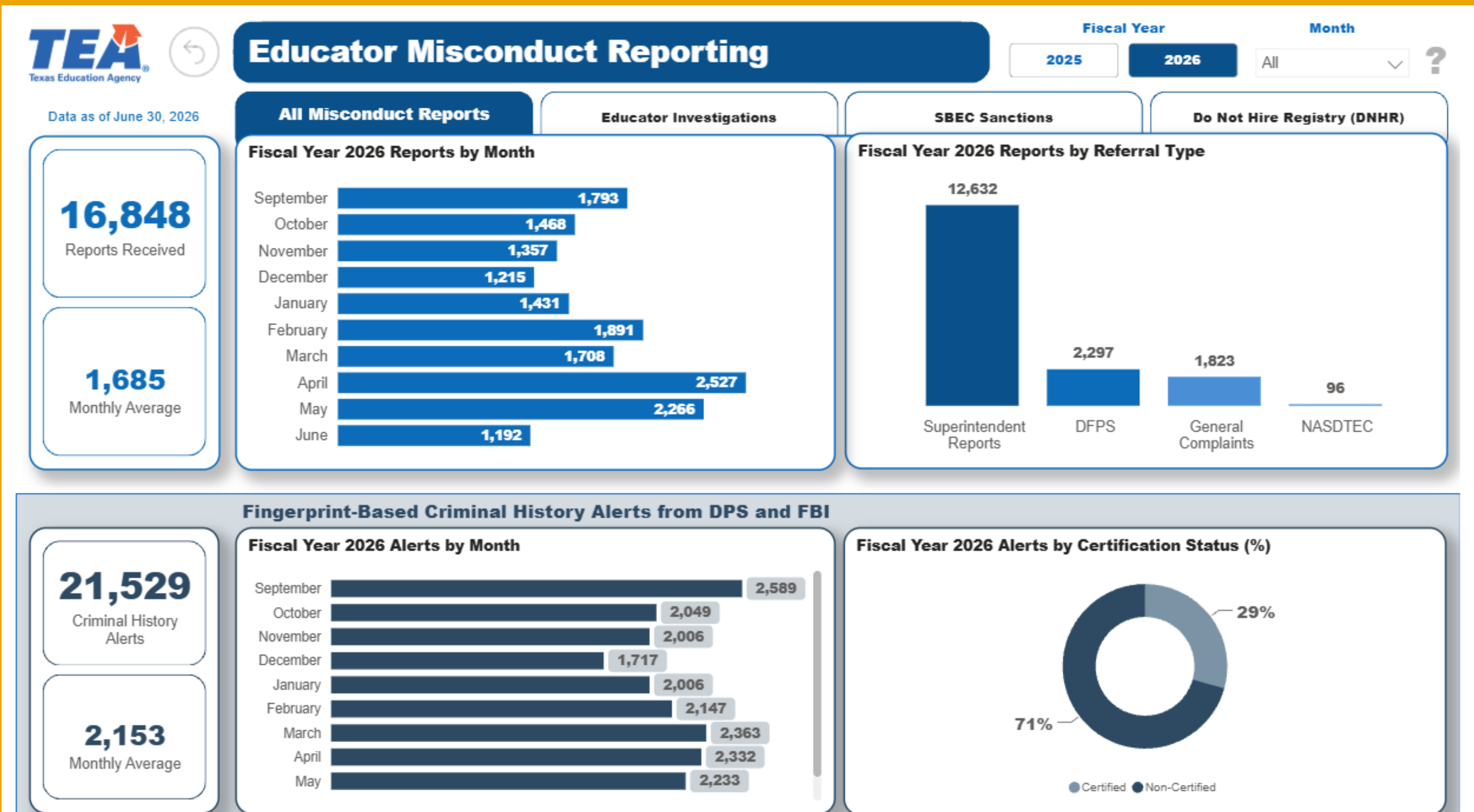




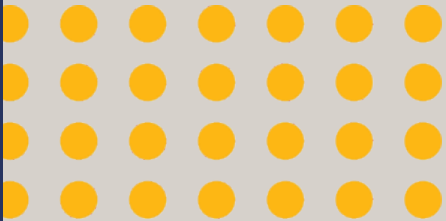
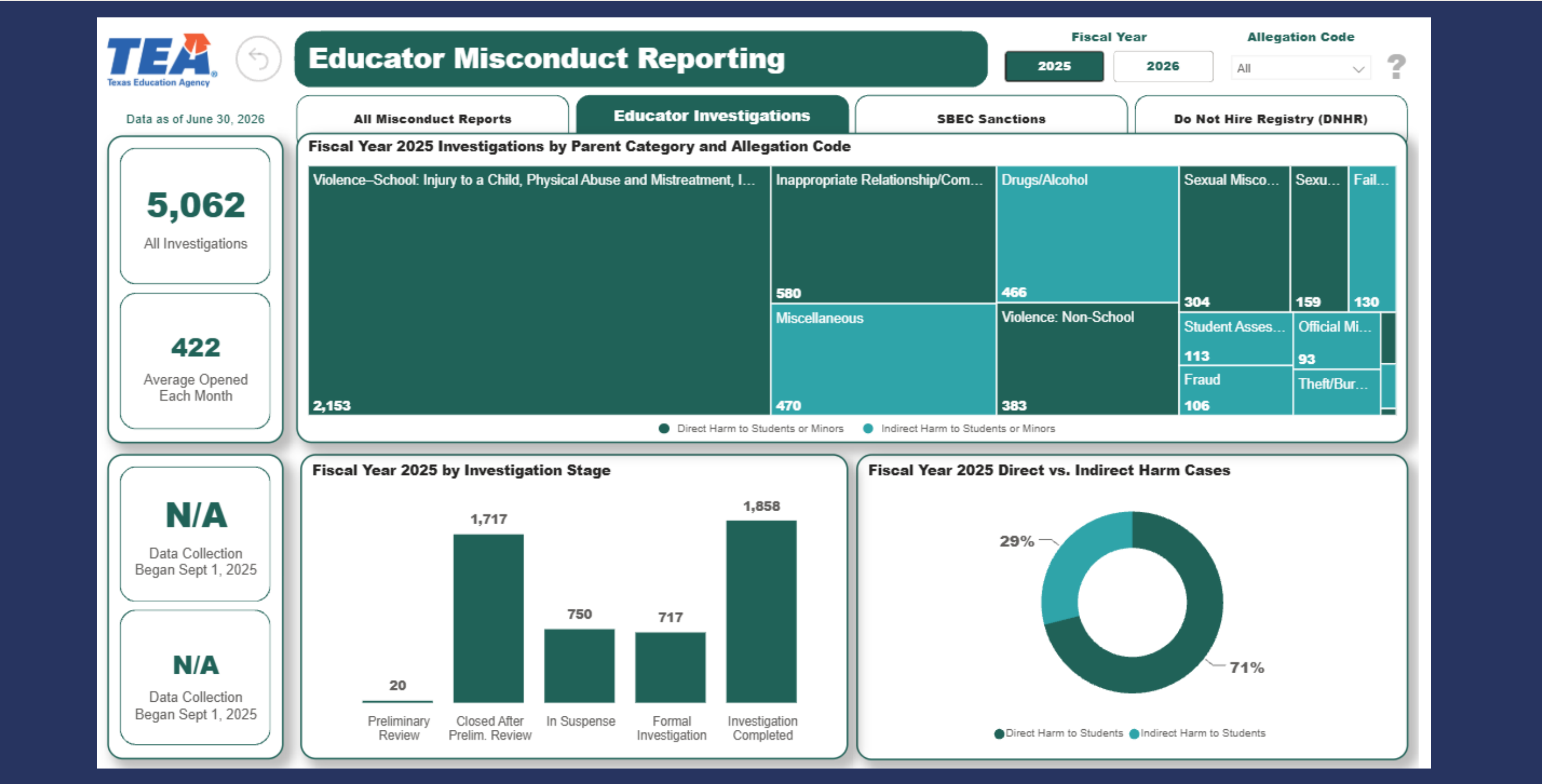
Educator Misconduct Reporting



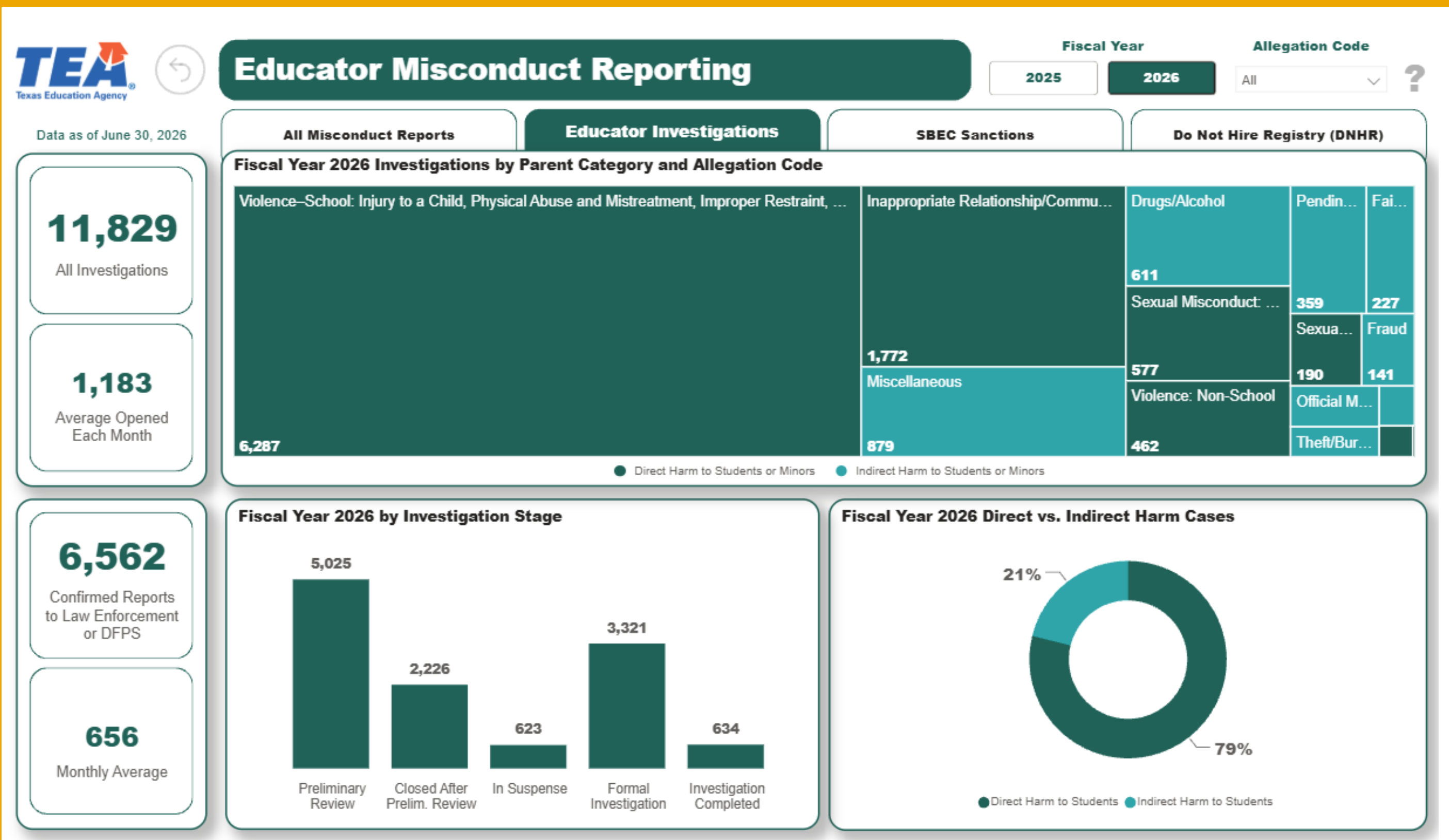
2026 Reporting



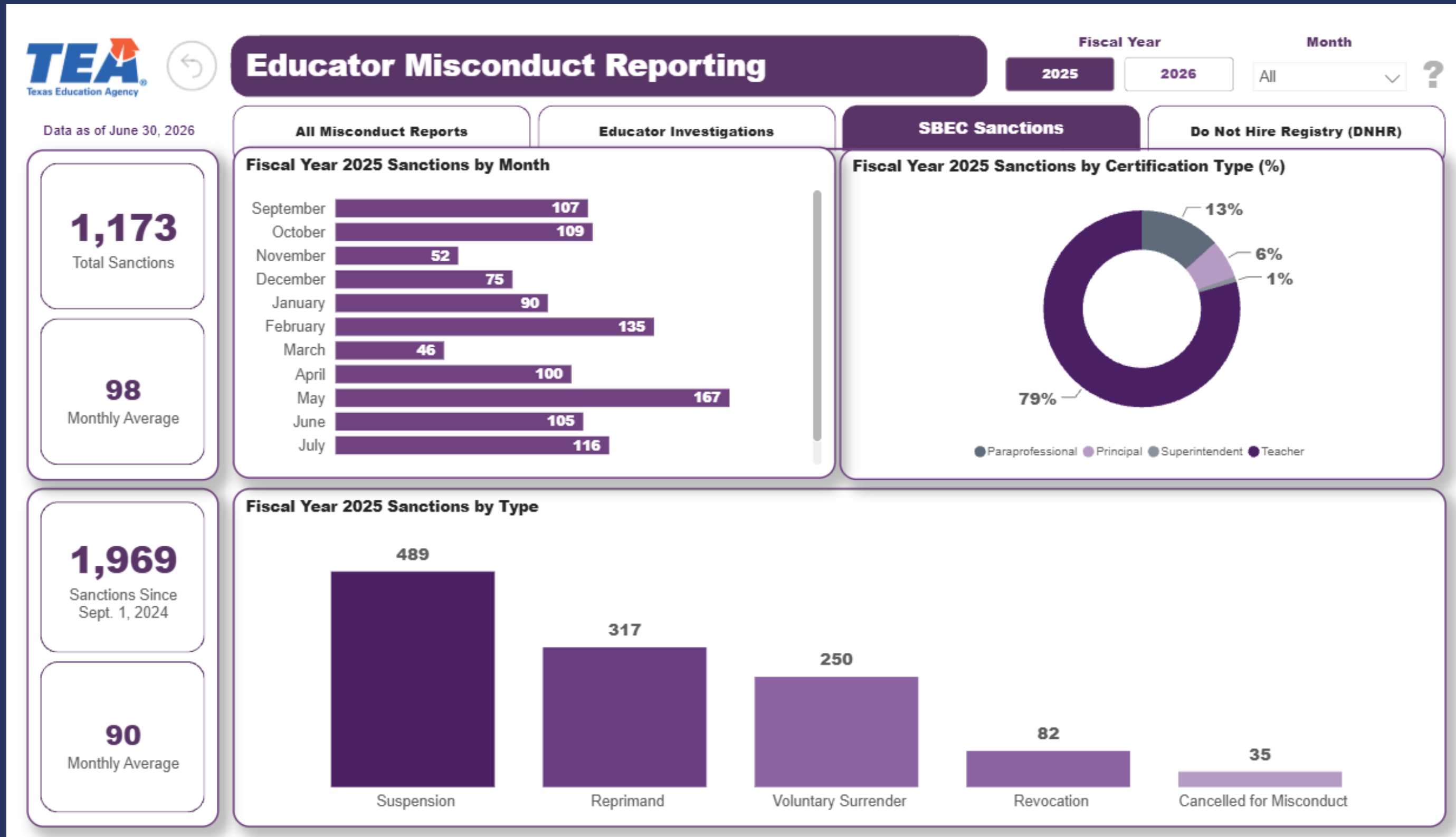
Educator Investigations



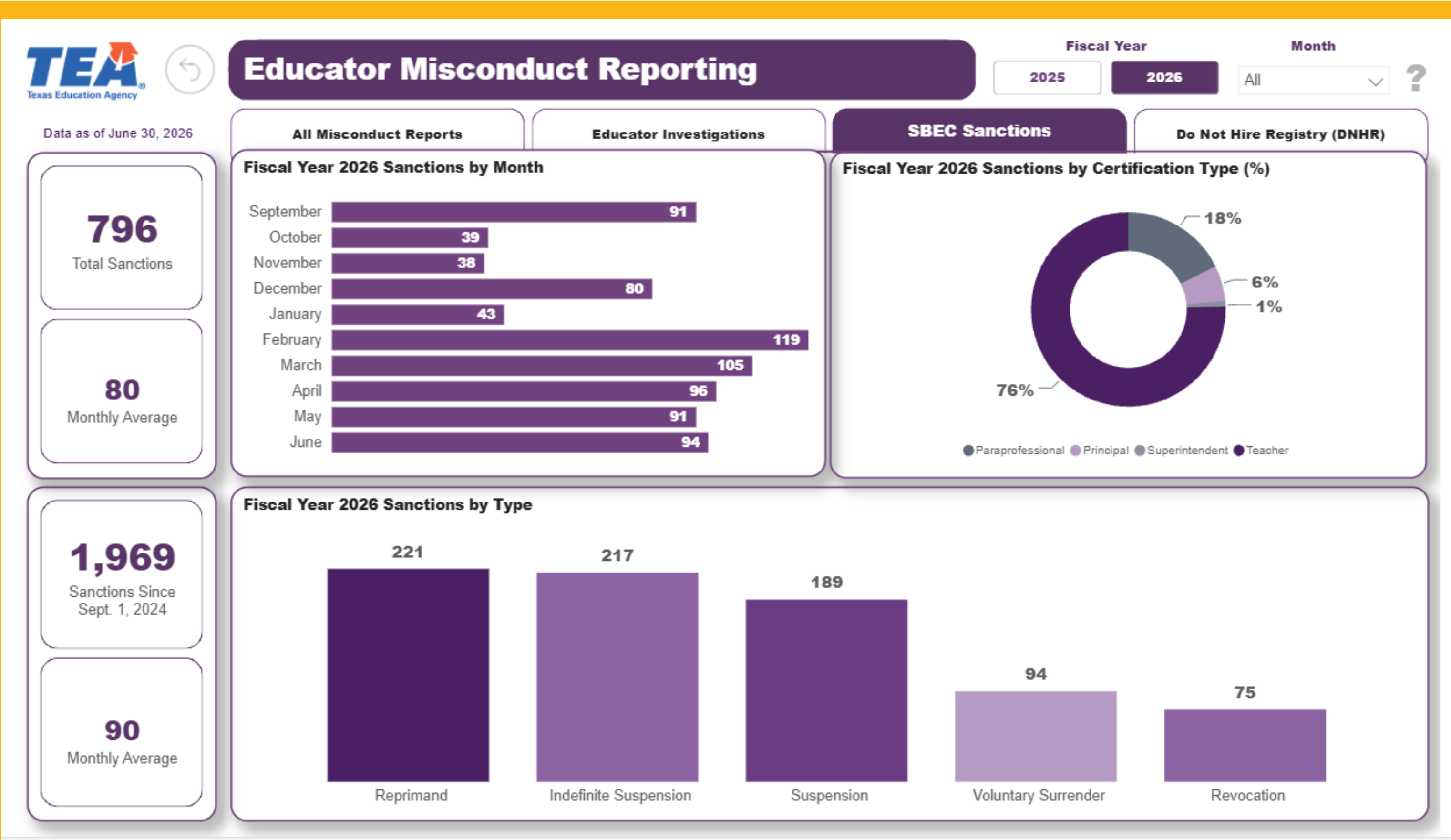
2026 Investigations

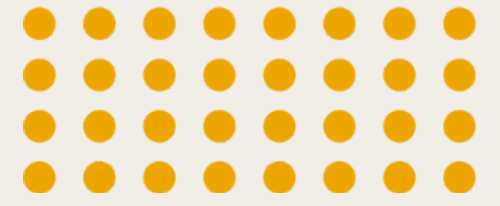
