SUBJECT:

Approval of the Memoranda of Understanding with Local Law Enforcement Agencies

RECOMMENDATION

The District President recommends approval of the Memoranda of Understanding with Local Law Enforcement Agencies, including the Cities of McKinney, Plano, Frisco, and Celina.

RATIONALE

Board Policy CHA(Local) requires that Memoranda of Understanding be approved by the Board of Trustees.

The Collin College Police Department and municipal law enforcement agencies have drafted MOUs to outline the mutual aid relationship between the College's Police Department and the various municipal Police Departments. New and updated agreements are signed by the respective Chiefs of Police on behalf of their organization, but require approval by the Collin College Board of Trustees. The Collin College Chief of Police and the District President or designee also review each Memorandum of Understanding annually, pursuant to Board Policy CHA(Local).

Statutory authority for mutual aid agreements is contained in Chapter 791 of the Texas Government Code and Section 362.002 of the Texas Local Government Code. These proposed mutual aid agreements allow for a member law enforcement agency to call upon other member agency(s) for assistance of additional personnel and equipment. The providing of assistance is discretionary with the requested member, and is subject to the availability of resources. No contractual obligation to provide resources is created, and all obligations under these agreements are voluntary.

These agreements become effective between the parties immediately upon execution. Any party to an agreement may terminate participation in the agreement by giving thirty (30) days written notice.
