# Where We Came From & Who We Serve

- Began in 2003 as Arkansas Virtual School as part of a pilot grant
  - Became a K-8 open enrollment charter school in 2007 as Arkansas Virtual Academy
  - Added grades 9-12 in 2014 with the first graduating class in 2017

## Currently:

- 5,301 students currently enrolled in grades K-12
- Free and Reduced Lunch: 57%
- Special Education: 16%
- CTE Pathway Participation: 100% of students in grades 6-12 (3,879)
- All teaching staff are Arkansas Certified Instructional staff

- **Elementary**

- 2022-23 F
- 2023-24 (simulated) C
- Increase in reading growth of 8.37 in reading

- **Middle School**

- 2022-23 D
- 2023-24 (simulated) B
- 82<sup>nd</sup> percentile for growth in the state

- **High School**

- 2022-23 D
- 2023-24 (simulated) C
- 50<sup>th</sup> percentile for growth in the state

- Increased Teacher Effectiveness
  - Visible Learning (John Hattie) on-going training
    - Administrative annual Visible Learning Training
    - Teacher Clarity (SY23-24)
    - PLC+ (SY24-25)
    - Visible Learning (SY25-26)
  - Bi-weekly Impact Meetings
  - Rigorous Observation Cycle
- Monthly Progress Monitoring of Student Standards Mastery
- Partnership with APSRC for literacy coaching
- Focused skills sessions and tutoring for standards mastery gaps
- On-grade level standards instruction daily
