Students and parents will be informed before the end of the year so BHA has a Fall plan in place and we aren't referring after the school year starts.

BHS Data:

1. 6 vaping referrals for the month of March- 31 students still haven't completed Everfi modules or weren't here for 4 hour class with Cinnamon. These students will need to complete this before attending prom.
2. ISS is still happening and has helped cut down on students roaming hallways and not attending class. Our attendance percentages have increased over the month and we know it will increase with ISS having another consistent person in there.
3. 17 discipline referrals were submitted for the month of March.
4. Home School Coordinator and School Counselors are continuing to pull attendance data on students and have targeted students/parent/guardians that still aren't coming consistently, attendance is falling off or they are missing 1-3 days a week. We have set up student solution meetings and are trying to work with students and parents to identify the problems and identify solutions to help increase attendance. 10 meetings have been set up for this week.
