GEAR UP

The GEAR UP student survey process is currently underway for students in grades 7–12. Survey participation remains a vital component of program evaluation, data collection, and continued grant support. The information gathered helps measure program effectiveness, student needs, college and career readiness indicators, and overall program impact across the district.

The program is currently working toward an 80% survey completion rate district-wide. Student participation is critical, as survey data directly supports reporting requirements and future program planning. The survey deadline is May 22, and staff continue coordinating efforts to encourage timely completion across all grade levels.

In addition, preparation of the 2026–2027 GEAR UP draft application and supporting program documentation is completed and ready for submission. The draft outlines projected programming, student support initiatives, postsecondary readiness activities, and continued alignment with grant objectives and identified student needs.

GEAR UP continues to prioritize data-driven planning, academic support services, and intentional postsecondary readiness programming to support long-term student success.
