### Child Care –

We have welcomed a few new babies last month so we are at full capacity with infants at the child care center. We are working with our STARS coach from Great Falls to make sure that we are able to complete training and remain in good standing as a STARS program. The infant/toddler room is full with 6 babies and 5 two year olds. The three year old room has eight children enrolled with two more completing paper work for enrollment.

The infant/toddler room curriculum has changed a little bit because of all the infants enrolled. The priority is now into individual development for each child instead of doing classroom/group activities.

### HiSet –

Jeri is back running at full capacity after the holidays. She has adult students working on the computer as well as individual tutoring. Currently she does not have any students ready to do the official HiSet test.

### FIT –

Still waiting to hire a FIT advocate. The month of February was pretty quiet because there was so much money from the Land Buy Back Program and many families through the community had a not so tough month. I still did quite a bit of transporting of students to and from school trying to keep them going to school. I do not have an updated homeless count because I haven't had the time, office space, or ability to go out into the community to find the families.
