AI Committees

- Our D103 AI Committees (one at each building) are meeting in late June/early July to continue our work on a comprehensive AI Literacy scope & sequence, and exemplar lessons for teachers at various grade levels and content areas to grab and utilize in their classrooms.
- The Lake County AI Leadership Collaborative is meeting again on June 22.
 - The work of the committee will focus on:
 - Continuing to collaborate on the creation of an AI literacy scope and sequence.
 - Discussing professional learning strategies, plans, and opportunities around AI.

D103 AI Guidelines

- We are in the final stages of revising our D103 AI Guidelines based on feedback from students, staff, and parents/guardians during the course of this past school year.
- The guidelines will be placed on the D103 website in an easy-to-navigate format, and certain parts will be duplicated across the website when appropriate, such as having the student-focused portion placed within the student handbook for Daniel Wright.
- This will be completed by the time students head back to school in August and will be communicated to families, staff, and students.

Summer Technology Projects:

- Preparation of new 1st and 5th-grade iPads.
- Installation and configuration of a new Firewall.
- Preparation of laptops for the refresh of Half Day teacher devices.
- Continue work on AI, Computer Science, and Digital Citizenship.
 - Prepare AI professional learning for the 26-27 school year.
- Prepare and implement a summer safety refresher where we invite D103 staff and community partners to refresh, level set, and level up our knowledge of safety practices.

- Prepare for the switch to internal support of printers - mainly developing the systems needed to maintain continuity of functionality and use.
