Crime Statistics Reporting

2023 Wisconsin Act 12 (the “Act”) created Wisconsin Statutes Section 118.124, which requires Wisconsin schools that operate high school grades, defined as grades 9-12, to annually report certain criminal incidents. Specifically, covered schools are required to collect and maintain certain statistics of incidents involving various crimes specified by the Act. The initial reporting requirement must be reported to the governing school board, which is required to submit the report to DPI on or before July 31, 2026, and prior to each July 31 thereafter.
