Red Wing High School Activities – COVID Response

(Revised 11.15.20)

- We are analyzing county numbers, community numbers, RWHS numbers, and RWHS Activities' numbers.
- Of the 47 students currently in quarantine, 5 are currently involved in activities and 10 have been, or will be involved in activities during the winter season.
- On November 5 and November 12, we had 5 or less athletes in quarantine.
- We have not had any transmissions between athletes OR coaches as well as in school transmissions between students/teachers.
- Our teams have yet to be quarantined as a group.
- Activities are 2-3 hours per day that we know what kids are doing.
- We are all well aware of the social/emotional impact activities have on our students and their overall mental health and well-being.

- Our coaches and students are adhering to the COVID protocols, provided by the MSHSL. They are below.

 - Activities may practice virtually only
