Texas Senate Bill 11Sec 37.108 Multi-Hazard Emergency Operations Plan: Security Audit:

(b) at least once every three years, a school district shall conduct a security audit of the district's facilities. To the extent possible, a district shall follow security audit procedures developed by the Texas school safety center or a comparable public or private entity.

(c) a school district shall report the results of the security audit conducted under Subsection (b) to the district's Board of trustees.

The audit results are required to be reported to the Texas School Safety Center.

Audit results should be held as confidentially as possible; the work papers are exempt from the Open Information Act, unless otherwise revealed.

Presentation History:

The first Security and Safety Audit was due August 31, 2008.

The second Security and Safety Audit was due August 31, 2011.

The third Security and Safety Audit was due August 31, 2014.

The fourth Security and Safety Audit is due August 31, 2017.

The fifth Security and Safety Audit was due October 31, 2020.

The sixth Security and Safety Audit was due September 15, 2023.

The seventh Security and Safety Audit was due September 15, 2026.

The Safety and Security Audit was completed before the due date by designated district personnel. Staff visited the campuses and with the assistance of onsite personnel, and reviewed the facilities during the process. All campuses security measures were acceptable or outstanding.

Recommendations will be discussed and appropriate actions will be taken to improve our safety and security.
