TITLE: Termination of Teacher's
Employment Pursuant to Texas
Education Code § 21.0031

ACTION

BACKGROUND:

On July 17, 2026, the Superintendent received notification from the Texas Education Agency ("TEA") that it entered an Order for Temporary Suspension against teacher Joseph David Carden Moseley's teaching credentials pursuant to Texas Education Code § 22A.203. Due to this action, TEA's notice provided that the teacher is not allowed to be employed by a school district or charter school within the State of Texas pursuant to Texas Education Code § 22A.151(d)(5).

CONSIDERATIONS:

- Approve terminating the employment of this employee pursuant to Texas Education Code § 21.0031, effective immediately.
- Do not approve terminating the employment of this employee pursuant to Texas Education Code § 21.0031, which means he would remain employed in MISD.

RECOMMENDATION:

The Superintendent recommends that the Board terminate the teacher's employment pursuant to Texas Education Code § 21.0031(b)(1)(A). TEA has temporarily suspended the teacher's educator certificates, and TEA has notified the District that the teacher may not be employed by a Texas school district.

If Board agrees, the motion would be:

"I move that the Board terminate the employment of teacher Joseph David Carden Moseley, pursuant to Texas Education Code § 21.0031, effective immediately, and authorize the Superintendent of Schools to provide the employee notice of the Board's decision."
