Wellness /Prevention

As for Wellness/Prevention, I have been meeting with the Tribal Health CEO to plan events, manage donations, and collaborate on various prevention activities for the summer. Continue working, Kari McKay, and follow up with students on the Insight list to ensure they complete their Everfi modules. The Insight class is held on Wednesdays for the middle school and high school. For students who need extra support, such as addiction and mental health counseling, I make referrals with the parents' consent to the following prevention/intervention programs.

Bobby, Leo, and I are planning the EOP and Sweet Pine Run for July. I have been working with the Tribal Health programs to donate funding or manpower for the upcoming events. The principals and counselors have been reaching out to external resources for students who violate offenses, and mental health services.

Here is the plan that is currently outlined in the High School and Middle School policy:

Offense #1: Verbal Warning

Offense #2: 4-hour Insight Class

Offense #3: Assessment completed by Licensed Addiction Counselor (LAC) and referral for treatment services with parent consent

Offense #4: Recommendation for additional disciplinary action and continued intervention planning with administration, counselors, and parents/guardians. Students may also be referred to

outside agencies or long-term support services depending on the severity and frequency of the behavior.

In addition to disciplinary measures, prevention and intervention strategies continue to focus on education, accountability, and student wellness. The goal is to reduce substance use, improve decision-making skills, and increase student awareness regarding the dangers associated with vaping, dabbing, alcohol, and drug use. Collaboration between school staff, Tribal Health, behavioral health services, law enforcement, and families remains essential to ensuring students receive the support they need.
