

Executive Summary: 2025-2026 District Goals Progress

This report highlights the district's progress as of May 2026. Notably, the district is exceeding its primary instructional targets while maintaining steady progress on long-term systemic goals. The final benchmark update will be provided at the June board meeting after quarter 4.

Goal 1: Instructional Framework & Essential Standards

- **Current Progress:** Recent classroom walkthrough data shows 88% of instruction is directly aligned to identified essential standards.
- **Performance vs. Target:** This exceeds the end-of-year target of 80%.
- **Implementation Activities:** Staff consistently leverage formative data and collaborative PLC time to tailor instruction to student needs.

Goal 2: District Benchmark Assessments (ELA & Math)

- **Current Progress:** iReady is our source for benchmarks K-8. High school benchmarks are in development.
- **Completed Milestones:**
 - Prioritized ELA and Math focus district-wide.
- **Next Steps:** Develop a long-term plan for all content areas by the 2028-2029 school year.

Goal 3: New Hire Induction & Support

- **Current Progress:** The Quarter 3 feedback survey has been completed to measure ongoing effectiveness and identify final refinements for the support program.
- **Ongoing Support:** The district continues to facilitate support workshops and monitor implementation through mentor reports and coaching logs.
- **Target:** The program remains on track to achieve a 5% increase in year-over-year retention.

Goal 4: Family & Community Engagement

- **Current Progress:** 75% of schools have now hosted school-led family engagement events.
- **Participation Trends:** Data indicated a 3-5% increase in participation over the previous year's baseline.
- **Focus Area:** Efforts are currently directed at increasing the survey response rate beyond 2024-2025 levels to ensure robust feedback for student success.

Goal 5: Facility Cleanliness & Safety

- **Current Progress:** Quarter 3 progress surveys and site inspections have been completed at 100% of school sites.
- **Monitoring:** The district continues to use site audits to identify repairs and provide targeted support to custodial teams.
- **Target:** The district aims for a final round of surveys in May to develop a comprehensive summer plan for the upcoming school year.
