BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Type: Consent

In accordance with TEA Financial Accountability System Resource Guide (FASRG) and with generally accepted accounting principles, funds that are obligated through issuance of a purchase order or a funds commitment, but are not expended at year-end, may be carried forward to the next fiscal year. This requires approval by the Board of Trustees, since these funds must actually be appropriated into the

new budget year. Such encumbered and committed funds will be presented to the Board for approval by fund and function at the Fall 2027 Board meeting. As part of the year-end process, fund balance accounts will be adjusted to reflect the appropriate balances required to meet district obligations.
