3. BYLAWS AND POLICIES

1. Bylaw 0100—Definitions (revised). Wireless communication devices are added to the definition of PCD. Recommended to keep policies current.
2. Policy 1410—Staff Ethics (new). New policy per Michigan Code of Education Code of Ethics. Recommend for review and adoption to remain current.
3. Policy 2370.01 —Online /Blended Learning (revised). Removal of the 15 day per year limit. Recommended for adoption to remain current.
4. Policy 2417— Comprehensive School Health Education (revised). Many additions and changes are included and removal of reference to 2012 2013 school year. Recommended for adoption to remain current. Changes have been made to MCL and the Michigan Health Education Standards.
5. Policy 2418—Sex Education (revised). Instruction may include controversial and sensitive issues. Opt out options are included.
6. Policies 3120.09 & 4120.09—Volunteers (rescinded).
7. Policy 8120.09—Volunteers (revised). New language and options are included. Volunteers will submit to background checks as required by the MDE and the MHSAA. Recommended for adoption to remain current.

8. **Policy 4210—Staff Ethics (new).** This new policy is referenced to MCL Michigan Code of Ethics for Educators. There are some options that should be reviewed by the Technology Director. 4210 should be adopted to remain current.
9. **Policy 5136—Wireless Communication Devices (Replacement).** This replacement policy should be reviewed by Technology and adopted to remain current.
10. **Policy 5336—Diabetes (new).** This client requested policy should be reviewed for consideration.
11. **Policy 6320—Purchasing (revised).** New language regarding competitive bids is provided. There is also optional language to be considered. The district Business Manager should review the changes. 6320 revisions should be adopted to remain compliant.
13. **Policy 6325—Procurement Federal Grants (revised).** New thresholds have been provided in the revisions and should be adopted to remain current.
14. **Policy 7540.09—Artificial Intelligence (replacement).** The Technology Director/Committee should review this replacement policy. The policy should be adopted to remain current.
15. **Policy 8402—Emergency Operations Plan (revised).** A protocol is included for the student use of wireless communication devices. This policy update should be adopted to remain current.
16. **Policy 8655—Specialized Transportation for Student With IEP's (new).** This new policy provides guidance as outlined in student IEP's. Policy 8655 should be adopted to remain current.
