Subject: School Improvement Plans

The Issue:

In June 2026 all of our schools worked collaboratively with their leadership teams to develop School Improvement Plans focused on literacy, numeracy, and a sense of belonging. These plans reflect each school's goals and strategies for continuous improvement and academic success and are directly aligned to each school's 2025–2026 performance data. Each year, the finalized plans are presented to the Board of Education.

Board Policy and Past Practices:

In alignment with past practice, schools completed their School Improvement Plans, which were then reviewed by the Learning and Leadership Department before being submitted to the Board of Education for approval. During the 2026–2027 School Year each school will deliver a presentation on the updates, their progress and status of these plans to the Curriculum Board. This process ensures ongoing accountability, supports continuous improvement across all schools, and provides the Board of Education and community with greater visibility into each school's improvement efforts.

Strategic Plan:

This recommendation supports East Aurora School District's Strategic Goal #3 Collaborative Leadership: East Aurora School District 131 will *engage in continuous improvements through collaborative, student-focused, and data-driven leadership* and Strategic Goal #4 Student Achievement: *East Aurora School District #131 will ensure the academic success of all students by closing the opportunity gap.*

Community Impact:

Each school's leadership team, which includes a variety of stakeholders, works collaboratively to develop a School Improvement Plan. This process is rooted in continuous improvement and is tailored to the unique needs of each school, using specific data and identified areas of support to guide planning, implementation, and monitoring. This collaborative planning process supports continuous improvement and helps ensure that every student has the opportunity to reach their full potential.

Supporting Data:

The current versions of all School Improvement Plans for our buildings are included. As part of our annual process, each school will present its School Improvement Plan during the 2026–2027 school year, beginning with the first presentations in September and concluding in May.

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Financial Impact:

Throughout the year, building leadership teams will collaborate on reviewing their School Improvement Plans, analyzing data, and making necessary adjustments to goals and actions. Activities associated with the implementation and monitoring of School Improvement Plans will be supported through available Title funding.

Recommendation:

It is recommended that the Board of Education approve the School Improvement Plans as presented, consistent with the District's annual planning and accountability process.
