**PHS Track & Field**

**PHS Baseball**

**Golden Ticket**

Moving to a Golden Ticket system prior to every activity beginning in order to make sure each participant has their forms complete. It is working well so far to ensure that we have all proper forms completed prior to students participation in an activity.

**Arbiter & Activities & Athletics Eligibility**

Beginning with the 2026–27 school year, the Alaska School Activities Association (ASAA) will transition to a new School Activities Reporting System (SARS) platform powered by Arbiter Registration. We are excited about the improvements and long-term support Arbiter Registration will provide to schools, students, and families. However, there will be one important change during this transition:

Parents and students will need to create a new Arbiter Registration account, as existing BigTeams account information cannot be transferred. Families should create one shared Family account rather than separate accounts for each user. Parents and students may begin creating their new Arbiter Registration Family accounts starting July 6, 2026.

**MMS New Eligibility Requirements for Homeschool/Alternative Education Participation**

For students enrolled in an accredited Homeschool/Alternative Education program intending to participate in any Mitkof Middle School Activity or Athletic Program, all prospective participants must meet the following in order to be eligible:

- 1) Enroll in a minimum of 2 courses at Mitkof Middle School with the following requirements:
  - a. One (1) course must be a core course of English, Math, Science, or Social Studies in their respective grade.
  - b. One (1) course may be an elective course if space allows within that elective.
  - c. Must complete the course in good academic standing of a minimum of a C- at the end of the enrolled quarter of that activity to continue participation in other activities.
- 2) Must meet all eligibility requirements in regards to Arbiter forms and fees to be able to receive a golden ticket for practice eligibility.
- 3) Must complete the Homeschool/Alternative Education form.
