Board Committees

The Board will not have ~~no~~ standing committees. ~~Special~~ ~~It may appoint special~~ committees may be appointed by the Board for specific purposes to serve until their assignment is completed. The entire Board may meet as a committee-of-the-whole.

The function of special committees will be fact-finding, deliberative and advisory, rather than legislative or administrative. The committee will make ~~Committee~~ recommendations ~~will be made~~ directly to the Board as a whole, which alone may take action. Committee meetings may be called by the Board chair ~~chairman~~, the committee chair ~~chairman~~ or any committee member ~~of the committee~~.

Committee-of-the-whole meetings, called “work sessions,” may be held. Committee-of-the-whole meetings may be called by the Board chair ~~chairman~~ or any two Board members.

All meetings of special committees and of ~~committees~~ ~~the committee~~-of-the-whole will follow the Public Meetings Law. ~~be publicly announced and the public will be permitted to attend.~~ The Board ~~or~~ and its committees, ~~however~~, may sit in an executive session ~~sessions~~ to discuss matters ~~when pertaining to individual personnel, students, collective bargaining and certain other matters where~~ such ~~session~~ ~~is~~ ~~sessions are~~ required or permitted by law.

All matters referred to a committee will be thoroughly investigated ~~by it~~. A committee will not have the power to act for the Board, ~~except as the Board has specifically authorized~~ ~~an action~~, but will make recommendations to the Board. Committee recommendations and reports will become an official part of Board minutes.

A Board committee may appoint, ~~subject to Board approval~~, advisory members from the staff, student body or community with approval of the Board. Advisory members will be instructed in the committee’s functions and their status. ~~Advisory~~ ~~These~~ members may not be included in considering whether a quorum of the committee is present, nor may they vote on recommendations to be made to the Board. ~~Either~~; ~~however, either~~ an advisory member or an ex-officio member may present ~~in writing~~ a written minority report to the Board.
