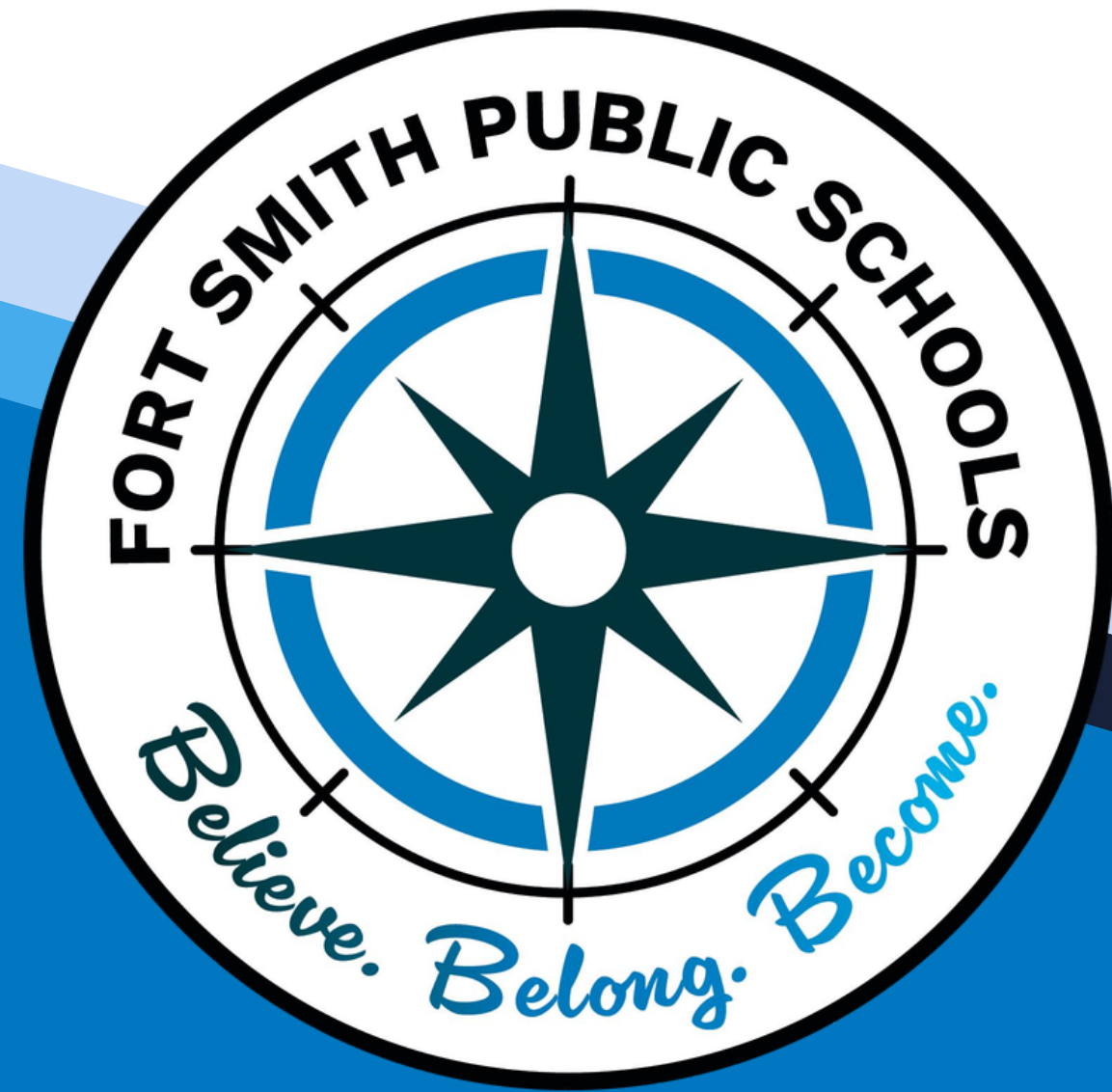

Effective Practices to be Replicated



Flexible Skill Groups

Students were grouped by need (letter recognition to comprehension) and adjusted continuously.



Targeted Foundational Support

Students lacking letter/sound mastery received an extra hour of explicit instruction.



Leveled & Mastery Texts:

Instruction used student-level passages alongside third-grade mastery and ATLAS texts.



Goal Awareness & Reflection:

Students tracked their progress toward K–3 standards and reflected on areas for improvement.
