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Open Enrollment Policy - Opportunities

Increased Student Enrollment

- Allows families outside the traditional attendance zone to enroll in the district.
- Helps offset declining enrollment trends.
- Increases ADA (Average Daily Attendance) funding from the state.

Next Steps

- **Revision of District of Innovation Plan to include:**
 - In accordance with the District's innovation plan and this policy, the District is exempt from the requirement for transfers to be for a one-year period. Therefore, violation of the terms of the agreement, falsification of any transfer document information, and/or failure to meet any of the factors for acceptance may result in the approved transfer status being immediately revoked or not being approved the following year.
- **Revision of Local Policy to include:**
 - In approving transfers or revoking or denying transfers, the Superintendent or designee shall consider availability of space and instructional staff, financial costs, safety issues, academic performance, disciplinary/behavioral history, and attendance/tardy records.
