Re: Revisions to Policy KK- Public Guest and Spectator Civility

Recommendation: That the Board of Trustees approve the revisions to LCSD Policy KK: Public Guest and Spectator Civility as a second and final reading.

Background Information

Policy KK outlines our commitment to maintaining a safe, respectful, and harassment-free workplace and learning environment for students and staff. The policy establishes clear expectations for mutual respect, civility, and orderly conduct among District employees, parents/guardians, and public guests on school premises and during extra/co-curricular or athletic events. It explicitly prohibits volatile, hostile, profane, or aggressive actions and language, and provides staff with specific protocols for addressing abusive or disruptive individuals. This includes spectator removal processes, involving law enforcement when necessary, and issuing "no trespass" ordinances.

The revised version of the policy introduces several key updates, as suggested by NIAA, to clarify terminology, streamline procedures, and formalize athletic event standards. A major update is the incorporation of the complete NIAA Spectator Policy as Appendix A, which details specific acceptable and unacceptable conduct, explicit intervention procedures (including warnings, immediate venue removal, future event suspensions, and mandatory behavior training for privilege restoration), and the rationale for enforcement.
