7. New Business

7.1. Elementary Math Changes Similar to Act 20

- The bill is currently stalled. It would require more support and regulation through 8th grade, but without additional funding, which is why DPI is not supporting it. Currently, we create PSP plans for targeted and intensive interventions in math and have already planned for PD next year.

7.2. Social Studies Adoption 6-12

- Teachers have been included from each of the buildings. Currently investigating and piloting HMH, Savvas and the updated version of McGraw-Hill, our current curriculum. The committee has been able to see each of the curricula in use in other districts. No final decision has been made yet. More updates to come. Seeking final approval on May 18.

7.3. High School Bag Restriction

- In preparation: 25-26 school year, all students were issued lockers; intermediate schools have had bags stored in lockers for the day for the last several years; Chromebook cases have been ordered for next school year. Options being reviewed and feedback from stakeholders continues to be collected. Next steps will be presented at the Board Workshop on April 20.
