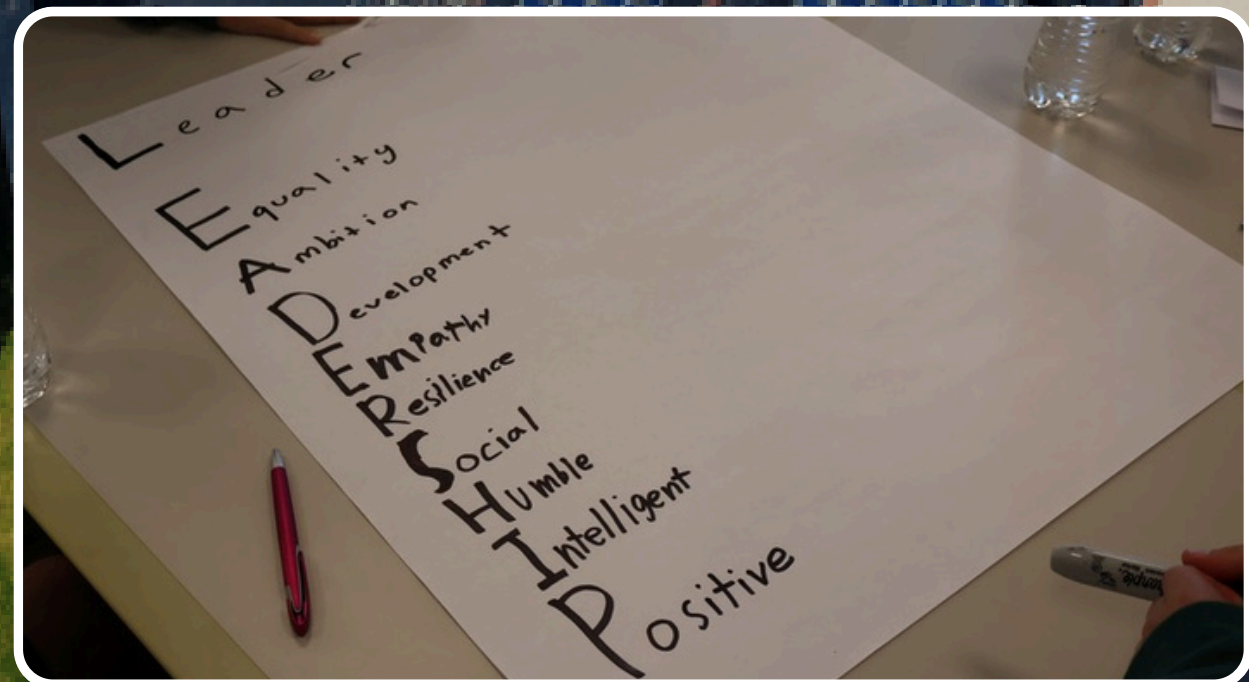

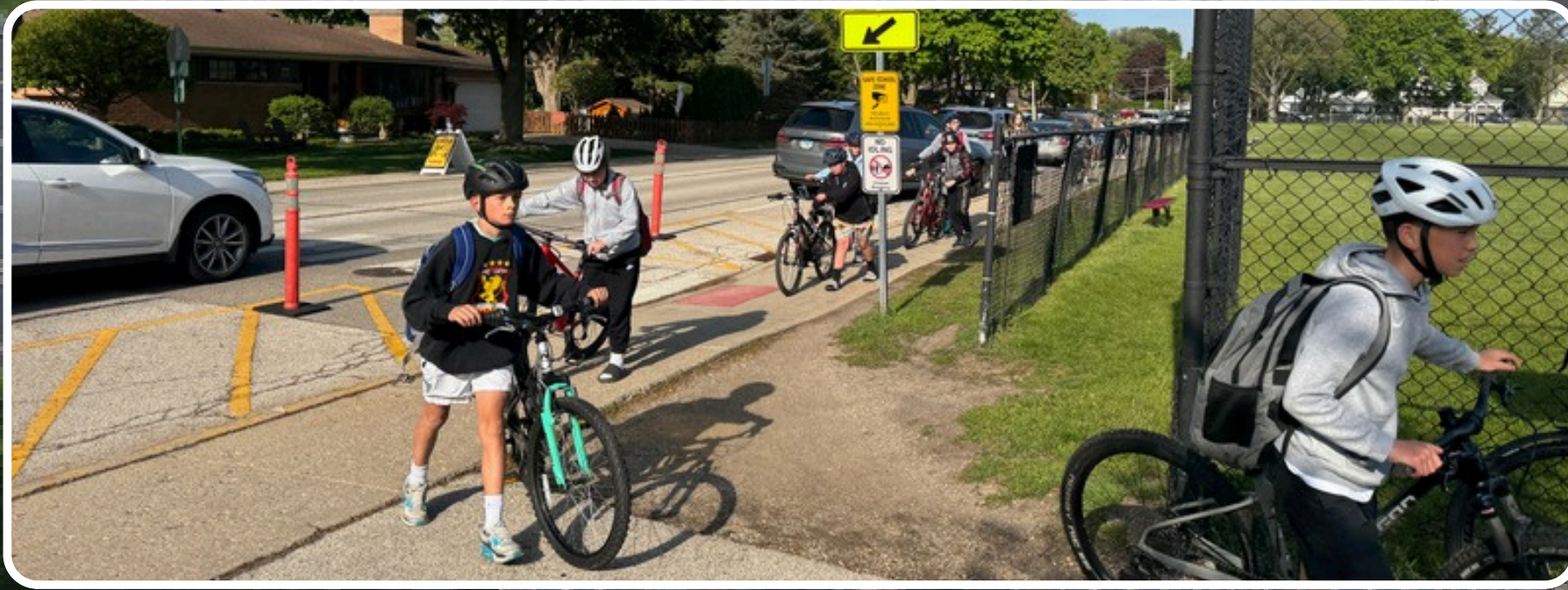
D70's last FAD meeting of the year. Thanks to all our parents/guardians serving on the Family Associations of District 70 for another great year of collaborative work!

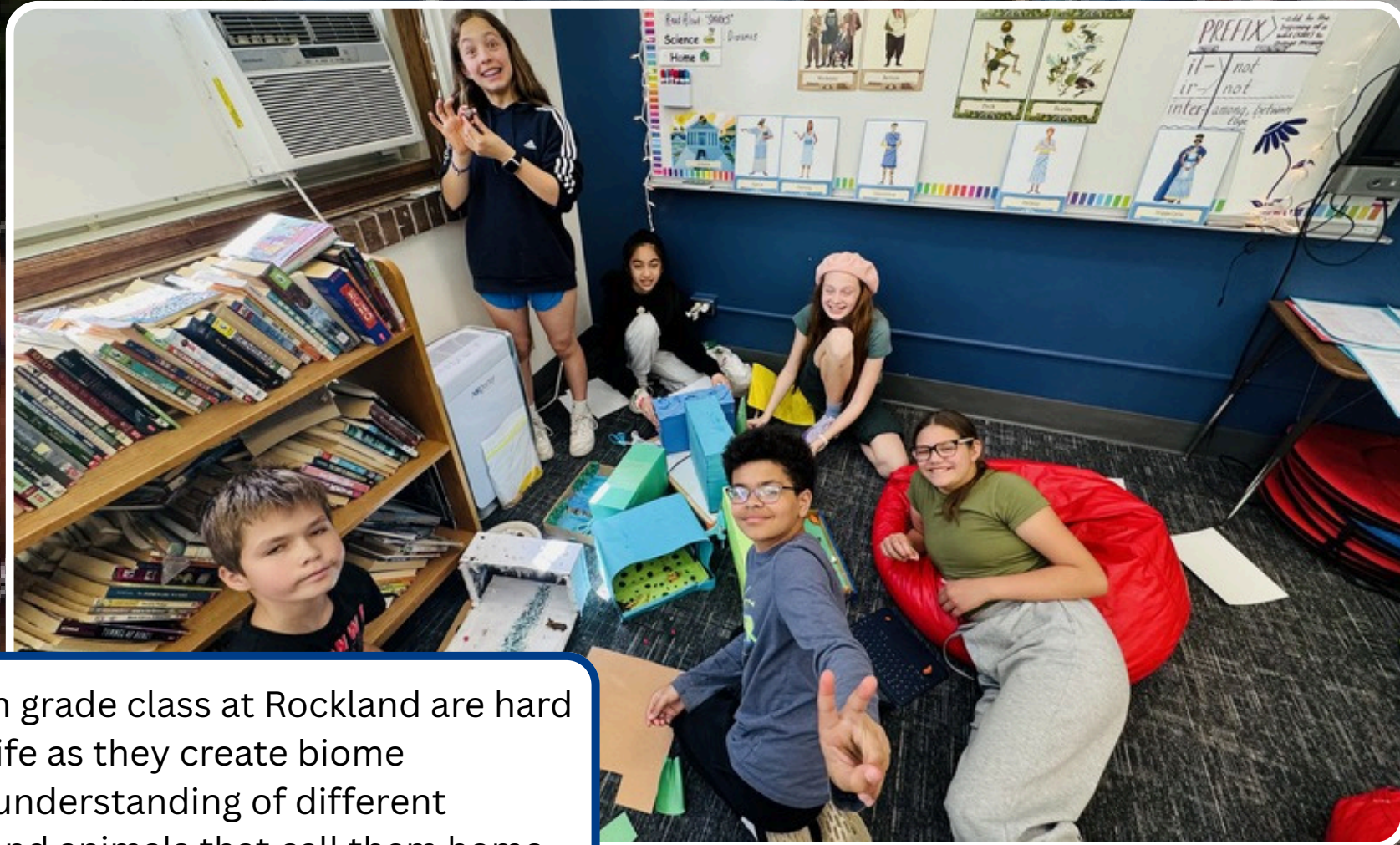
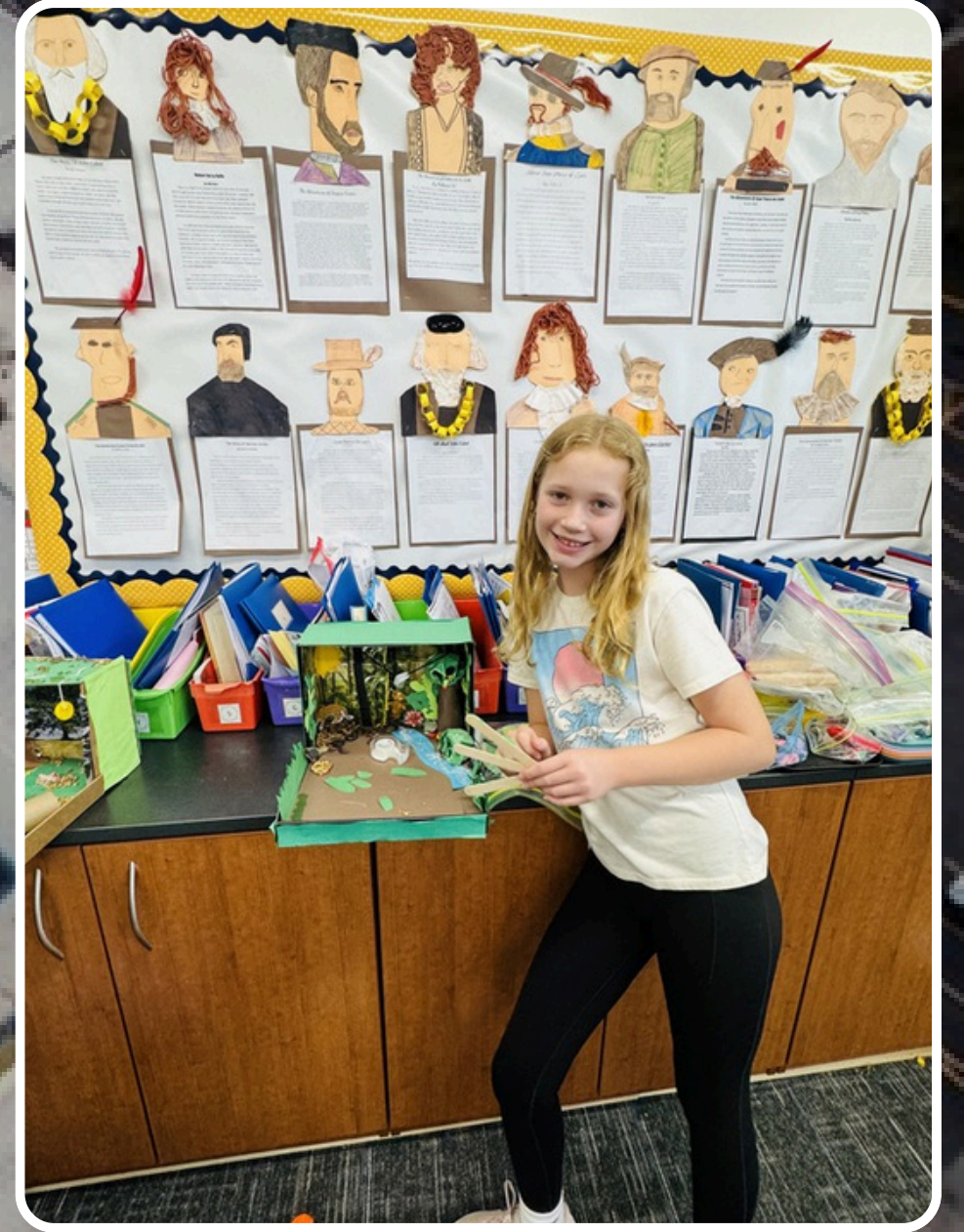


Adler Park 5th grade explorers took a creative approach to learning, designing life-sized portraits of early English settlers from Roanoke, Jamestown, and Plymouth.

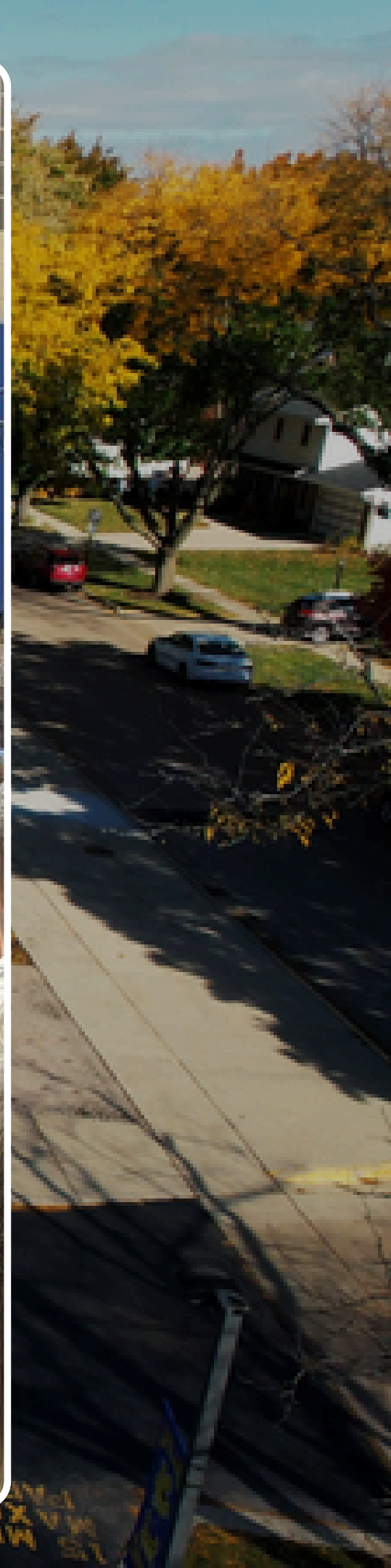


Rockland School proudly celebrated it's 1<sup>st</sup> grade students officially joining the Rockland Circle of Readers!
