Academics

- Continued analyzing student data and made adjustments to the JAMS schedule to strengthen MTSS supports.
- Maintained the block schedule while building in dedicated Tier 3 intervention and study hall time.

Athletics/Clubs

- Volleyball Camp: 16 participants attended volleyball camp during the week of July 6. The camp was led by Gina James, Beth Merker, Cam Schwemmer, and Gwen Panzau.
- Soccer Camp: 20 participants attended soccer camp during the week of July 13. The camp was led by Kerri Thaler and Jada Hendrix.
- Basketball Camp: Basketball camp will be held the week of July 20 at JAMS for students in grades 1–8.
- Baseball & Softball Camp: Baseball and softball camp will be held the week of July 27 at JAMS for students in grades 3–8.

Professional Development
