The following preamble and resolution were offered by Member _____ and supported by Member _____:

WHEREAS:

1. This Board intends to submit a proposition at a special election to be held on Tuesday, August 4, 2026.

2. On or before 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, May 12, 2026, the Board shall certify any ballot proposition to be submitted to the voters at such election to the election coordinator or coordinators designated to conduct elections within the Intermediate School District (the “Election Coordinator”).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

1. A special election of the electors of the Intermediate School District be called and held on Tuesday, August 4, 2026.

2. The proposition to be voted on at the special election shall be stated on the ballots in substantially the form as set forth in Exhibit A with the Superintendent of Schools authorized to adjust the language of Exhibits A and B, upon consultation with election counsel, to the extent necessary to (1) seek the restoration of millage lost in 2026 as a result of the Michigan Constitution of 1963, in order to achieve the total millage stated in Exhibits A and B, if permitted by law, or (2) seek the renewal of the District’s millage at the 2026 millage rate as reduced by the Michigan Constitution of 1963.

3. The Election Coordinator is requested to:

a. Utilize the Daily News, a newspaper published or of general circulation within the Intermediate School District, for publication of notices in accordance with the election law requirements.

b. Utilize ballot proposition summary information, as prepared by legal counsel, in the forms of the notices of last day of registration and election in substantially the form as set forth in Exhibit B attached hereto.

c. Provide a proof copy of the ballot to the Intermediate School District and its legal counsel in sufficient time to allow the ballot to be proofread prior to printing.

4. The Secretary of this Board is hereby authorized and directed to file a copy of this resolution with the Election Coordinator and with any Election Clerk or clerks designated to conduct elections within the Intermediate School District by 4:00 p.m., on Tuesday, May 12, 2026.

5. All resolutions and parts of resolutions insofar as they conflict with the provisions of this resolution are hereby rescinded.

EXHIBIT A

**IONIA COUNTY INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT
SPECIAL EDUCATION MILLAGE PROPOSAL**

This proposal will allow the intermediate school district to continue to levy special education millage previously approved by the electors and restores millage lost as a result of the reduction required by the Michigan Constitution of 1963.

Shall the currently authorized millage rate limitation of .4013 mill (\$0.4013 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation), on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property in Ionia County Intermediate School District, Michigan, to provide funds for the education of students with a disability, be renewed for a period of 10 years, 2027 to 2036, inclusive, and also be increased by .1323 mill (\$0.1323 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a total of .5336 mill, for a period of 10 years, 2027 to 2036, inclusive, the estimate of the revenue the intermediate school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2027 is approximately \$1,509,968 from local property taxes authorized herein (this is a renewal of millage that will expire with the 2026 tax levy and a restoration of millage lost as a result of the reduction required by the Michigan Constitution of 1963)?
