Summer School Programs

Background Information

Weatherford ISD is committed to supporting student growth through a variety of summer learning opportunities designed to meet the needs of identified students across all grade levels.

In compliance with Texas Administrative Code (TAC) §89.1250, Weatherford ISD will offer a state-required summer school program for English Learners who will be eligible for enrollment in kindergarten or first grade in the upcoming school year.

Beyond the required program, the district is providing additional summer learning opportunities for qualifying students in grades K–8 to support continued academic progress. At the high school level, students will have access to credit recovery in core content areas and targeted support for June End-of-Course (EOC) retesting.
