The Annual Compliance Report for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025 is currently listed on the agenda for this Tuesday's Board meeting. I would like to provide a brief update regarding the timing of the report.

As part of the audit process, the district worked with our external auditors, Burton, McCumber, & Longoria, LLP, to ensure all financial information is accurate and complete. Following the submission of the District's final adjusting journal entry, additional adjustments were identified and processed to fully reflect the District's financial activity. Due to the timing and number of these final adjustments, Burton, McCumber, & Longoria, LLP has indicated that additional review time is necessary to complete all required audit procedures in accordance with professional standards.

As a result, the Annual Compliance Report will not be finalized in time for presentation at Tuesday's meeting. This delay is procedural in nature and reflects the district's commitment to accuracy, transparency, and compliance rather than any audit concerns.

The audit is continuing as planned, and we anticipate presenting the Annual Compliance Report to the Board for approval at the proposed February 19, 2026 Special Called Board Meeting. Please feel free to contact me if you have any questions or require additional information.
