Agenda Item: Consider Recommendation by Administration to Contract for Unarmed and Armed Security Guard Services with L and P Global Securities, LLC Not to Exceed \$100,000

Summary:

State law, Section 37.0814 of the Texas Education Code, requires that school districts have commissioned police officers or a commissioned peace officer employed as security personnel on every campus during regular school hours. Terrell ISD has created commissioned police officer positions for all campuses in the District. However, to date, we have not been able to hire for all positions. Using a 3rd party to provide commissioned peace officers employed as security personnel will allow us to continue staffing campuses with armed personnel as required by state law.
