Summary:	This item requests approval of the Budget Impact Statement for the Police/School Liaison Interlocal Agreement between the City of Corinth and Denton ISD whereas City of Corinth shall provide Denton ISD with one certified police officer to serve as a school resource officer (SRO).
Background Information/ Previous Board Action:	This is a service provided by The City of Corinth to assist our schools in Corinth's jurisdiction with School Resource Officers. The SRO will be assigned to Crownover Middle School per the current MOU signed May 10, 2022. The Denton ISD Board of Trustees have approved similar agreements with the City of Denton, Denton County Sheriff's Department, Town of Little Elm, and the City of Oak Point to provide SROs to our campuses in their jurisdiction.
Potential Operational Impact:	Establishes and delineates the mission of the SRO Program. Also, formalizes relationships between the participating entities to foster an efficient and cohesive program that will build a positive relationship with the youth of the community.
Potential Financial Impact:	One SRO at 75% reimbursement for salary and benefits for a total of \$113,582.40.
Recommendation (Consent or New Business Only):	Approval of Budget Impact Statement for SRO MOU between the City of Corinth and Denton ISD where City of Corinth will provide one certified police officer.
