Adopt formal policies in response to 2025 Wisconsin Act 89 Requirement: 0144.5, 1213/3213/4213, 7530.02, 7540.03, 7544, 8210, and 8462.

Background:

This Special Update was issued to Neola Clients in response to 2025 Wisconsin Act 89 (Wis. Stat. 118.07(7)), enacted in March 2026, that requires all public and private schools to adopt formal policies by September 1, 2026, governing appropriate communication between employees and students both during and outside school hours. The law mandates annual staff training to help school personnel identify, prevent, and report "grooming" behaviors and professional boundary violations. Furthermore, it requires schools to establish clear consequences for these violations, which can include the termination of employment.
