Entrance Age

OSBA does not have this policy. It is addressed in other policies.

A student will be admitted into kindergarten if his/her fifth birthday occurs on or before September 1, as established by law. In addition, a student whose fifth birthday occurs after that date may be admitted to kindergarten if he/she:

1. Is a kindergarten student transferring from a public school in another district, or from a private school; or
2. Has completed the following criteria to the satisfaction of the superintendent or designee:

Interview:

The parent must interview with the superintendent or designee and kindergarten teacher. The child must interview with the kindergarten teacher.

Testing:

The child must successfully complete a district readiness test which will establish a baseline for a continuing record of educational progress and predict readiness for school activities. The child will also complete a comprehensive test to demonstrate outstanding ability or potential in academic performance. The test will be administered by licensed South Coast Education Service District, or district, personnel, as deemed appropriate by the superintendent. Testing costs shall be the responsibility of the parent.

The parents of a child entering school for the first time shall bring the child's legal birth certificate or other proof of the child's birth date for verification of the child's age. The child shall not be considered enrolled and shall be barred from instruction until such time that the appropriate documentation is presented to the school.
