- Ryan Korolewski and Lori Holm presented last week at “Charting the C’s”, highlighting our work as part of the Region 10 Mentor Program for teachers. CVSEC was an early adopter of this initiative, which focuses on strengthening teacher development through structured mentoring, coaching, and retention practices that support long-term staff success. Their presentation reflected our commitment to building internal capacity and supporting high-quality instruction across our programs.
- Our STEP Ambassadors for Respect have been actively presenting in 4th grade classrooms across member districts. This student-led initiative focuses on promoting inclusion, kindness, and disability awareness, while also building leadership and communication skills for our students.
