**APPROVE AND RATIFY THIRD AMENDMENT
WITH INLAND SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA UNITED WAY, INC.
FOR GUARANTEED INCOME PILOT PROGRAM
FROM OCTOBER 25, 2023 - SEPTEMBER 30, 2026
(CONTRACT NO. CF24136)
[\$2,563,871.12 - PROP 10 FUNDS]**

SUMMARY OF REQUEST

Approve and ratify the Third Amendment to Contract No. CF24136 with Inland Southern California United Way, Inc. to extend the contract term from July 1, 2026, through September 30, 2026 and increase the not-to-exceed amount by \$250,000, from \$2,313,871.12 to \$2,563,871.12 to fund costs related to local evaluation and final reporting of the Guaranteed Income Pilot Program.

BACKGROUND

Inland Southern California United Way, Inc. (ISCUW) has successfully concluded the participant payment phase of the Guaranteed Income (GI) Pilot Program in Riverside County, which provided monthly stipends to 409 pregnant individuals.

With the direct stipend distribution period now complete, additional time and funding are required for ISCUW to complete local evaluation activities and final reporting for Riverside County. The State's grant funding supports the statewide evaluation of the Guaranteed Income Pilot Program and does not provide sufficient funding for the local evaluation and reporting needed to document Riverside County's implementation, participant experience, local findings, and strategic recommendations. This amendment does not change the core scope of the pilot; rather, it provides dedicated local funding to complete the evaluation and closeout activities necessary to understand and report the pilot's local impact.

This amendment increases the total contract amount above the original \$2,500,000 Proposition 10 match amount previously authorized by the Commission. While the participant stipend match was adjusted through prior Commission actions based on the final CDSS award, actual enrollment, and later technology needs, these additional funds are separate and dedicated exclusively to local evaluation activities and preparation of the final report.

It is requested that the Commission approve and ratify the Third Amendment to Contract No. CF24136 with ISCUW effective July 1, 2026, although the agreement is being presented for approval at the Commission meeting on July 8, 2026. The July 1, 2026 effective date is necessary to ensure continuity of evaluation and final reporting activities.

Prior Commission Action:

On March 11, 2026 (Action Item 26-10): the Commission approved the Second Amendment to Contract No. CF24136 increasing the not-to-exceed amount by \$105,271.12 for payment platform and technology related costs.

On September 11, 2024 (Action Item 24-28): the Commission approved the First Amendment to Contract No. CF24136 reducing the Proposition 10 match funds to \$2,208,600 due to a revised CDSS award supporting a maximum of 409 pregnant participants.

On October 26, 2022 (Action Item 22-36): the Commission approved Proposition 10 match funds in an amount not to exceed \$2,500,000 for the GI Pilot.

RECOMMENDED ACTION

That the Commission:

1. Approve and ratify the Third Amendment to Contract No. CF24136 with Inland Southern California United Way, Inc. to extend the contract term by three (3) months, effective July 1, 2026 through September 30, 2026, and increase funding by \$250,000, resulting in a revised total contract amount not-to-exceed \$2,563,871.12 for the full revised term of October 25, 2023 through September 30, 2026; and authorize the Executive Director to execute the amendment on behalf of the Commission, subject to County Counsel approval as to form; and
2. Authorize the Executive Director, based on the availability of fiscal funding, to sign amendments that exercise the options of the executed Contract No. CF24136 as amended, on behalf of the Commission, including modifications of the statement of work that stay within the intent of said contract without requiring further action from the Commission, provided such modifications do not increase the not-to-exceed amount.

BUDGET IMPACT

Adequate appropriation has been included in the approved budget for Fiscal Year 2026/2027 (527980-25800-938001-92960).
