Grading System

The district's ~~reporting~~**grading** system shall be based on Board-adopted course content and ~~clearly show~~**is designed to enable** the student and parent ~~whether~~**to clearly know how well** the student is achieving course requirements at the student's current grade level or course content level; shall ~~and~~ be based on the student's progress toward mastery of a continuum of academic knowledge and skills; and may be based on the student's progress ~~becoming proficient~~ in a continuum of knowledge and skills that are not academic and that may include student behaviors that are defined by the district. Absenteeism or misconduct shall not be the sole criterion for the reduction of a student's grades.

Letter grades will be used in the district.

Grading will be ~~conducted~~ on a semester basis with progress reported at 6 weeks, 12 weeks and 18 weeks. Grades will be based on many factors, such as: basic assignments, both oral and written; class participation; special assignments; research; activities of various types and kinds; and special contributions. Semester grades will be recorded on high school transcripts each semester during high school.

At the beginning of the grading period students and parents will be informed regarding the basis of the grades and the methods to be used in determining them.
