Draft Updates

BP 5:50	Drug- and Alcohol-Free Workplace; E-Cigarette, Tobacco, and Cannabis Prohibition	The policy is updated for continuous improvement.
BP 5:250	Leaves of Absence REQUIRED QUESTION: How many employees are employed by the district, including part-time workers? ○ 51 or more full- or part-time employees. (Default) ○ 50 or fewer full- or part-time employees. (IASB will substitute the following sentence: "If the District employs at least 16 but not more than 50 employees, an employee is entitled to a total 10 days of unpaid leave while a child of the employee is a patient in a NICU.")	The policy and Legal References are updated in response to the Family Neonatal Intensive Care Leave Act, 820 ILCS 157/, added by P.A. 104-259, eff. 6-1-26, allowing employees to take a specified amount of unpaid leave if their child is a patient in a neonatal intensive care unit. The policy is also updated for continuous improvement.
BP 5:330	Sick Days, Vacation, Holidays, and Leaves	The policy and Legal References are updated for the reasons stated in 5:250, <i>Leaves of Absence</i> , above. The policy is updated to reflect current district practices.
BP 6:170	Title I Programs	The policy, Legal References, and Cross References are updated. The policy is updated to more closely align with federal statutes and guidance and terminology used by ISBE, and to ensure compatibility with the U.S. Dept. of Education's revised non-regulatory guidance. The Legal References and Cross References are updated for continuous improvement.
BP 7:185	Teen Dating Violence Prohibited	The policy and Legal References are updated. The policy is updated for continuous improvement. The Legal References are also updated in response to 105 ILCS 5/27-240, renumbered by P.A. 104-391.
BP 7:260	Exemption from Physical Education	The policy and Legal References are updated in response to a five-year review. The policy is updated with minor style changes. The Legal References are updated in response to 105 ILCS 5/27-710, renumbered by P.A. 104-391.
