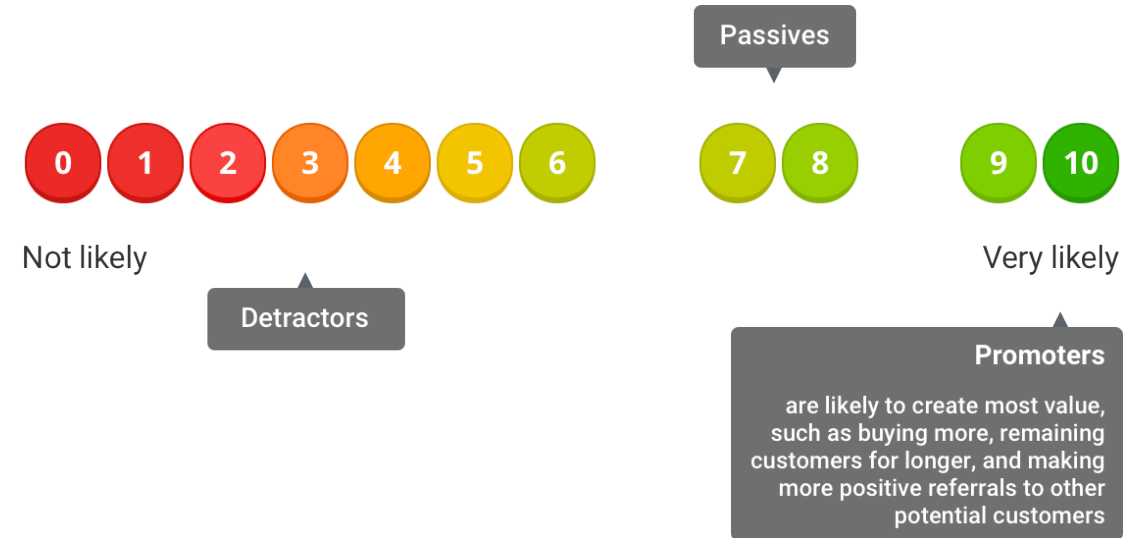


Net Promoter Scores
