New Business:

A motion was made by Mr. Cameron, seconded by Mr. Hatch, to approve consent agenda items as follows: 1) approval of minutes of the Regular Meeting of May 11, 2026; Board Workshop of May 12, 2026; Special Meeting of May 19, 2026; 2) approval of Bills and Warrants as of May 31, 2026; 3) approval of Library Resource Materials purchase list; 4) approval of Board resolution for submission of the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant; 5) approval of Fiscal Auditing Services contract with Gowland, Morales, and Smith PLLC contract for CISD 2026 Annual Financial Statements; 6) approval of CISD Board meeting dates for 2026-2027. The motion carried 7-0 with the record vote as follows: Luckenbach, Hatch, Walker, Cameron, Batek, Wells and Schulze all voting yes. Motion passed.

A motion was made by Mr. Cameron, seconded by Mr. Hatch, to approve SB 12 Compliance Certification as presented. There was no public testimony shared. The motion carried 7-0 with the record vote as follows: Luckenbach, Hatch, Walker, Cameron, Batek, Wells and Schulze all voting yes. Motion passed.

A motion was made by Mr. Cameron, seconded by Mr. Hatch, to approve the Interlocal Participation Agreement with TASB Energy Cooperative. The motion carried 7-0 with the record vote as follows: Luckenbach, Hatch, Walker, Cameron, Batek, Wells, and Schulze all voting yes. Motion passed.

A motion was made by Mr. Cameron, seconded by Mr. Wells to approve the district-wide Chromebook purchase from Howard Technology Solutions in the amount of \$229,398. The motion carried 7-0 with the record vote as follows: Luckenbach, Hatch, Walker, Cameron, Batek, Wells and Schulze all voting yes. Motion passed.

A motion was made by Mr. Hatch, seconded by Mr. Cameron, to approve Helping Hands Pediatric Rehabilitation Services, PLLC for Occupational Therapy Service contract on "as needed" basis not to exceed \$100,000.00. The motion carried 7-0 with the record vote as follows: Luckenbach, Hatch, Walker, Cameron, Batek, Wells and Schulze all voting yes. Motion passed.

A motion was made by Mr. Cameron, seconded by Mr. Hatch, to approve the proposal for Wood River Elementary and Calallen High School Roof repairs with Legefey Roofing:

- Wood River Elementary \$349,374.97
- Calallen High School 400 Hallway \$68,495.00
- Additional contingency to address Calallen High School roofing concerns \$300,000

The motion carried 7-0 with the record vote as follows: Luckenbach, Hatch, Walker, Cameron, Batek, Wells and Schulze all voting yes. Motion passed.

A motion was made by Mr. Cameron, seconded by Mr. Hatch, to approve United Health Care as the 2026-2027 employee health insurance benefit provider effective, September 1, 2026, and provide a District paid Hospital Indemnity Plan as presented effective September 1, 2026 for the 2026-2027 fiscal year forward, and delegate authority of the Acting Superintendent, Superintendent, Assistant Superintendent, or designee to negotiate and execute a contract and to bring back the executed contract to the Board at a future meeting for informational purposes. The motion carried 6-1 with the record vote as follows: Luckenbach, Hatch, Walker, Cameron, Batek, and Schulze all voting yes and Wells casting the dissenting vote. Motion passed.

A motion was made by Mr. Cameron, seconded by Mrs. Schulze, to approve Update 127 with additions, deletions, and revisions to LOCAL policies as follows:

The motion carried 7-0 with the record vote as follows: Luckenbach, Hatch, Walker, Cameron, Batek, Wells and Schulze all voting yes. Motion passed.

A motion was made by Mr. Cameron, seconded by Mrs. Schulze, to approve the CISD Board resolution for the 2026-2027 Good Cause Exemption as presented. The motion carried 6-1 with the record vote as follows: Luckenbach, Hatch, Walker, Cameron, Batek, and Schulze all voting yes and Wells casting the dissenting vote. Motion passed.

The Board discussed pursuing the RFQ process for legal representation and the timing for the RFQ. Discussion only. No action taken.

Mrs. Luckenbach declared under the authority of Texas Open Meetings Act, Government Code Section 551.074 for the purpose of considering the appointment, employment, evaluation, reassignment, duties, discipline or dismissal of a public officer or employee or to hear complaints or charges against a public officer or employee and Section 551.082 for matters involving the discipline of a public-school child; 1) Level III parent complaint and explained the Board would not be hearing 2) Expulsion appeal, and that the Board goes into executive session at 7:36 p.m.

Executive session was closed and regular session resumed at 8:49 p.m.

A motion was made by Mr. Cameron, seconded by Mrs. Schulze, to deny the Level III parent complaint and remedies therein requested. The motion carried 3-2-1 with the record vote as follows: Luckenbach, Cameron, and Schulze all voting yes; Hatch and Wells cast the dissenting votes; Batek abstained. Mrs. Walker who attended via Zoom was not in on the Closed Session and therefore did not cast a vote. Motion passed.

There was no action taken on the appeal of the student's expulsion as the parent was granted a delay until the next Regular Meeting on July 13, 2026.
