Guiding Outcome:	Excellence in Student Outcomes
Summary:	This item requests approval of the contract from College Board in the amount of \$175,224.19 for College, Career, and Military Readiness (CCMR) through the administration of the SAT Suite of Assessments
Background Information/ Previous Board Action:	Denton ISD participates in the SAT Suite of Assessments to promote college readiness for all students. The contract was previously approved in 2025-2026 and reflects the annual contract with College Board. PSAT 8/9 for 8th graders: October 19-23; AP Potential data used to recruit students for honors, dual credit, and AP programs in high school. PSAT/NMSQT for 10th graders and PSAT/NMSQT for select 11th graders: October 20; AP potential data used to recruit students for honors, dual credit, and the AP program. Participation in National Merit Scholarship program for 11th graders. SAT School Day: March 3; SAT administered on regular school day instead of Saturday.
Potential Operational Impact:	The approval of the contract and purchase will allow the District to continue to promote college readiness through the SAT Suite of Assessments.
Potential Financial Impact	Under HB3, the District anticipates receiving a refund of testing in the amount of \$115,357.00, which would be applied to this contract.
Recommendation (Consent or New Business Only):	It is recommended that the College Board's College Readiness and Success Agreement contract be approved.
