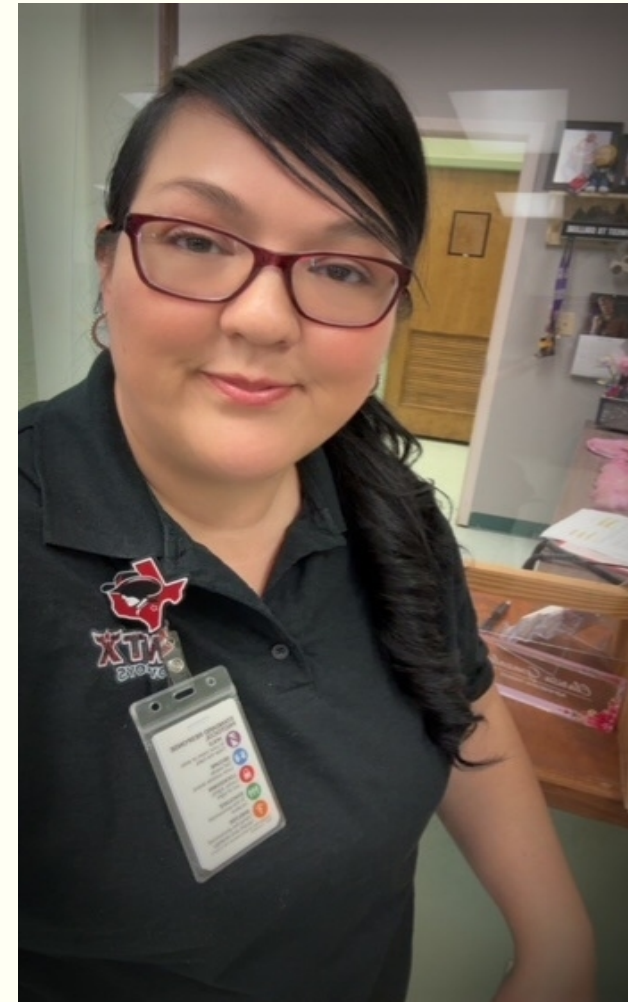

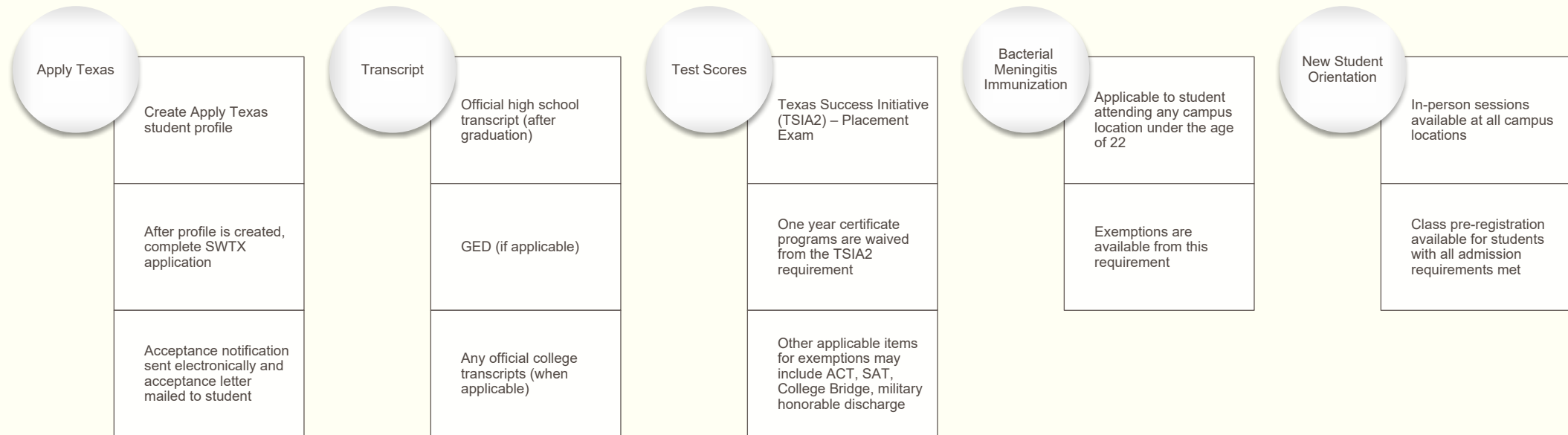

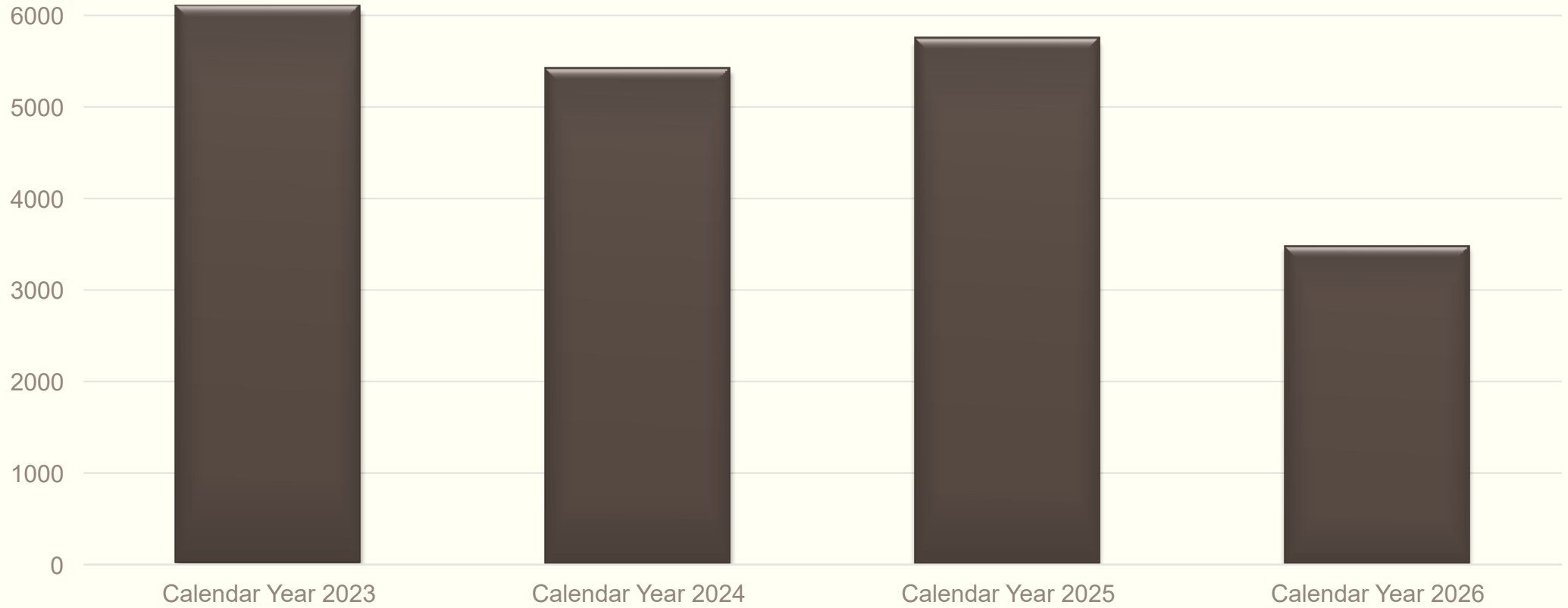
New Student; Dual Credit/Early College; Readmission; Transfer Students; International Students

- **New to College (First Time Students):** Apply Texas application; High School transcript or GED; Texas Success Initiative (TSIA2); Bacterial Meningitis Immunization (under age 22); and New Student Orientation

**One-year basic/advanced certificate programs have a waiver from the TSIA2 placement exam

- **Dual Credit/Early College:** Apply Texas application; High School transcript (after graduation); Dual Credit admissions form; Texas Success Initiative (TSIA2); Bacterial Meningitis Immunization (if attending SWTX campus); and New Student Orientation
- **Readmission (Former Students):** Complete Readmission form; submit any applicable transcripts such as prior college transcript(s) for external credit review
- **Transfer Students:** Apply Texas application (or readmission if applicable); Texas Success Initiative (TSIA2 if applicable); submit all individual college transcripts for external credit review; Bacterial Meningitis Immunization (if applicable)
- **International Students:** Apply Texas application; Texas Success Initiative (TSIA2 if applicable); transcripts; Bacterial Meningitis Immunization (if applicable); I20, SEVIS Fees (\$350); US Consulate appointment to review full-time school enrollment, SEVIS receipt, I-20, Financial statements from sponsor, passport/VISA, and birth certificate

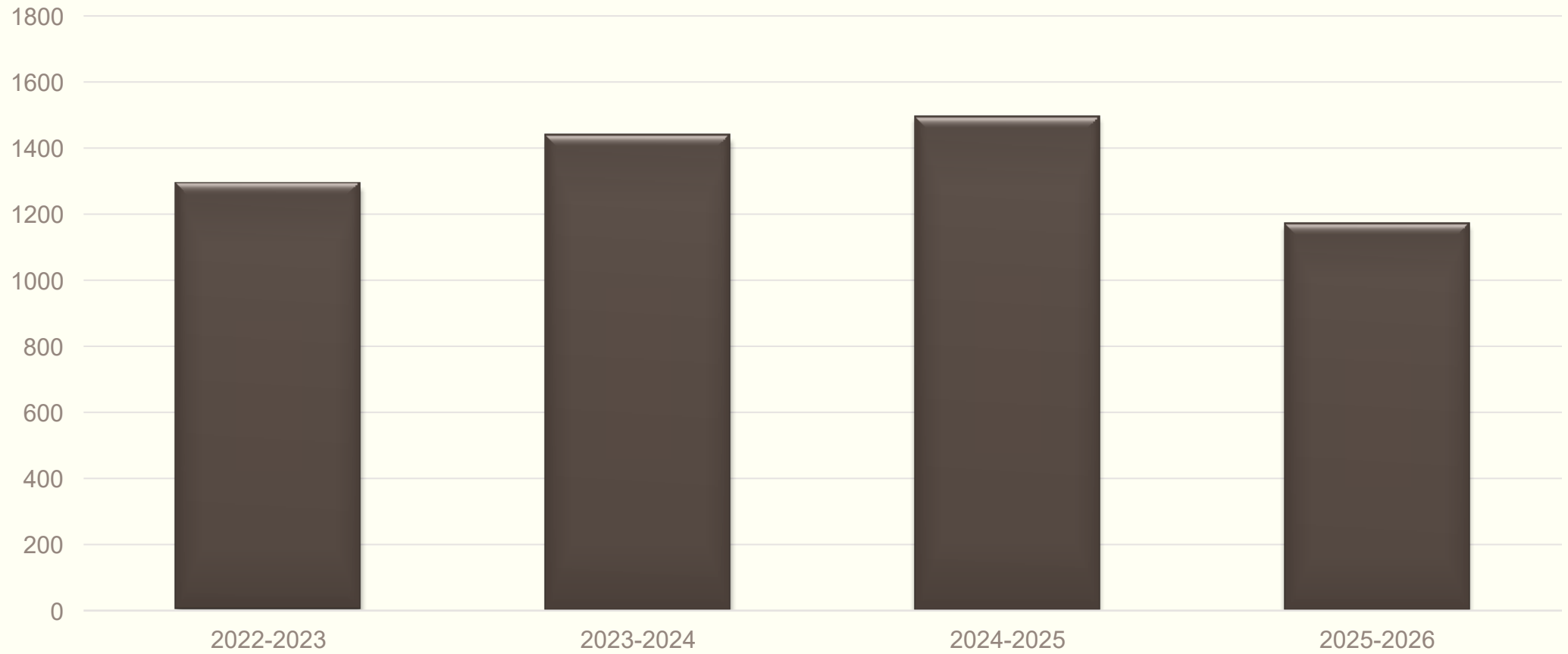
