Background Information: Texas Education Code § 28.004 requires each school district to establish a Student Health Advisory Council (SHAC) to assist the district in ensuring that local community values are reflected in the district's health education instruction and to provide recommendations on coordinated school health programming. Annually, the Board of Trustees approves the SHAC Committee members. Additionally, the SHAC is required to submit an annual written report to the Board of Trustees outlining its activities and recommendations. The 2025–2026 SHAC Annual Report highlights the council's meetings, membership, health and wellness initiatives, curriculum recommendations, and other activities conducted throughout the school year in support of student health, safety, and well-being.
