After six years of teaching, he went back to school to earn his Juris Doctor at the University of Houston Law Center. He received an Education Finance Certification from Georgetown University. He brings a variety of educational experiences to the position. Ms. Ann Williams holds a bachelor's degree in information technology, an MBA in project management, and certifications as a Texas Principal (EC-12) and a Transformational Life Coach. She is currently serving as an Instructional Curriculum Coach in Spring ISD. Ann is widely respected as a trainer, mentor, and governance expert. She has facilitated board governance workshops throughout Texas. She also serves on the TASB Energy Cooperative Board, supporting innovative and cost-effective solutions for school districts.
