Farmington High School entrepreneurship students raise money for pediatric cancer research

Farmington, MI -- A Project Based Learning (PBL) assignment in a Farmington High School (FHS) entrepreneurship class led to students raising \$1,070 for pediatric cancer research for the University of Michigan.

Students in Nina Merget's entrepreneurship class were given the task to raise money for a charity. The class determined that they wanted to raise money for pediatric cancer and wanted it to have an impact locally. Therefore, whatever they raised would be donated to the University of Michigan. Merget facilitated discussions on what they were going to sell, how they were going to advertise it, how much it would cost, and what their profits might be if they sold all of their stock.

The class decided to make special edition pink shirts for the Pink Out Homecoming Football Game. Students collaborated to design, physically print, promote, and sell the shirts. Merget taught students how to create a design using Transfer Express and helped them learn how to use a T-shirt press to physically print each shirt. Shirts were sold by the entrepreneurship and DECA students for \$10 each. Overall, the group sold 200 shirts and made a profit of \$1,070, all of which was donated to pediatric cancer research.

"I am so proud of my students for going through the entire process to develop, produce, price and promote a product while raising money for charity," stated Merget. "They worked hard to sell all of their shirts to maximize their donation!"

"I learned that charity is just worth the work, no matter what it is," stated Yatin Bichala. "It felt similar to community service in that it was selfless and infinitely rewarding. We never once thought about being rewarded, and that puts a smile on my face."

Dear Mr. Barth:

This letter transmits an update from Plante Moran Cresa (PMC) as it relates to the assignment to assist and advise Farmington Public Schools (FPS) in its selection of Prime Contractors for the 2020 Bond Projects listed above. This update represents the mutual efforts of PMC, Wakely Associates, Peter Basso & Associates, McCarthy & Smith and FPS administration and staff (Project Team) to present a framework in order to identify, evaluate and recommend Prime Contractors for these Projects.

The Project Team has diligently worked to continuously validate the project scope sheets for the Projects listed above, reviewed proposed drawings and performance specifications, met with district personnel, and aligned the release and bid due dates to ensure good bid coverage for the District.

On September 21, 2021, an advertisement for bids was posted to the required State of Michigan website. In addition, the advertisement was posted to the District's website as well as a local newspaper. Construction Documents and Specifications were formally issued and made available to interested bidders via web-based portals.

Relative to Bid Pack #4 – Renovations to Various Schools, seventy-nine (79) bid proposals were received on October 21, 2021 (and October 27, 2021 for the Steel, Hard Tile, Painting, Athletic Equipment, Telescoping Stands, and Fencing bid categories). During the next two weeks, bid proposals were reviewed to determine the scope, schedule, budget, and other financial implications. Interviews were held with the recommended bidders and were attended by various members of the Project Team.

Upon completion of the interviews, and after subsequent clarifications and discussions, the Project Team is recommending the firms listed in McCarthy & Smith's Award Recommendation Letter for Bid Pack #4 – Renovations for Various Schools for contract award. The recommendation includes the acceptance of two voluntary alternates proposed by the recommended bidders in Bid Division 136 – Telescoping Stands and Bid Division 133 – Electrical and are further described in McCarthy & Smith's recommendation letter. The recommendation also includes the acceptance of the following bid alternates:

Alternate #1: Hillside: West Playpad Replacement	\$ 39,650.00
Alternate #2: Hillside: Art Room Casework Replacement	\$ 24,550.00

Including hard construction of \$6,668,205.00 and construction contingency of \$666,821.00, this Project award recommendation equals \$7,335,026.00.

For the Prime Contractors, the cost for the Work will be detailed in AIA Contract A132 – 2019 Standard Form of Agreement between Owner and Contractor, as modified pending final review and approval of terms by district legal counsel.

Including the recommended voluntary and bid alternates, the recommendation for Bid Pack #4 – Renovations to Various Schools is approximately 10% under the established budget for the Projects. The majority of this work will be performed during the school recess in the summer of 2022, however opportunities to complete work during other times will be explored and discussed with FPS.

The Project Team is available at the Board’s convenience to answer any questions regarding bidding, the proposals, interview process, or the recommendation of the Project Team.

SUBJECT: Summer Tax Collection Resolution

DATE: November 9, 2021

On an annual basis, the Board of Education is presented with a resolution regarding the collection of property taxes. We have continued in our practice of a 50/50 collection of summer and winter taxes, largely due to the financial impact it would have on the local taxpayers with a shift to 100% summer collection.

The timing of the collection does not impact the total dollars to the District; however, it does impact cash flow. With a 100% summer collection, we would collect our cash from property taxes at the beginning of the fiscal year which helps ensure that we could weather tough financial times as well as reduce or eliminate the need to borrow cash. By moving to a 100% summer tax collection, it would also move up the timing for payment of taxes for our community members. The impact would be felt by those who pay their taxes directly as they are accustomed to paying it in two increments. For those who pay their taxes through escrow arrangements (typically as part of their mortgage payments), it is possible that the impact would be less evident as it is spread throughout the year through their monthly mortgage payment. The Cities do not have the information regarding what percent of the homestead taxes are collected through mortgages versus direct payment.

For the upcoming year I am recommending that we stay with a collection of 50% in the summer and 50% in the winter. The board may want to consider moving to a 100% summer collection in the future but we would need time to help the community understand the impact. We also added to fund balance for the June 30, 2021 fiscal year and we have been in a position of not having to borrow for cash flow purposes for the last five years.

Michigan Public Act 333 of 1982 requires that a school district determine by resolution their intent to levy a summer tax and that each taxing municipality be notified of such action prior to January 1st. In keeping with our twice-a-year collection of prior years, we will need to take action before December 31, 2021.

Therefore, **IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT THE BOARD APPROVE THE SUMMER TAX COLLECTION RESOLUTION** at the November 23rd meeting and waive the reading of the resolution.

Mrs. Dawn Eisenscher and her husband moved to Farmington Hills in 2007, when she was pregnant with their daughter. Her daughter is now a Freshman at North Farmington High School. They also have a 4th grade son at STEAM. Dawn is an active member of the STEAM PTSA, and this will be her 5th year as their Treasurer.
