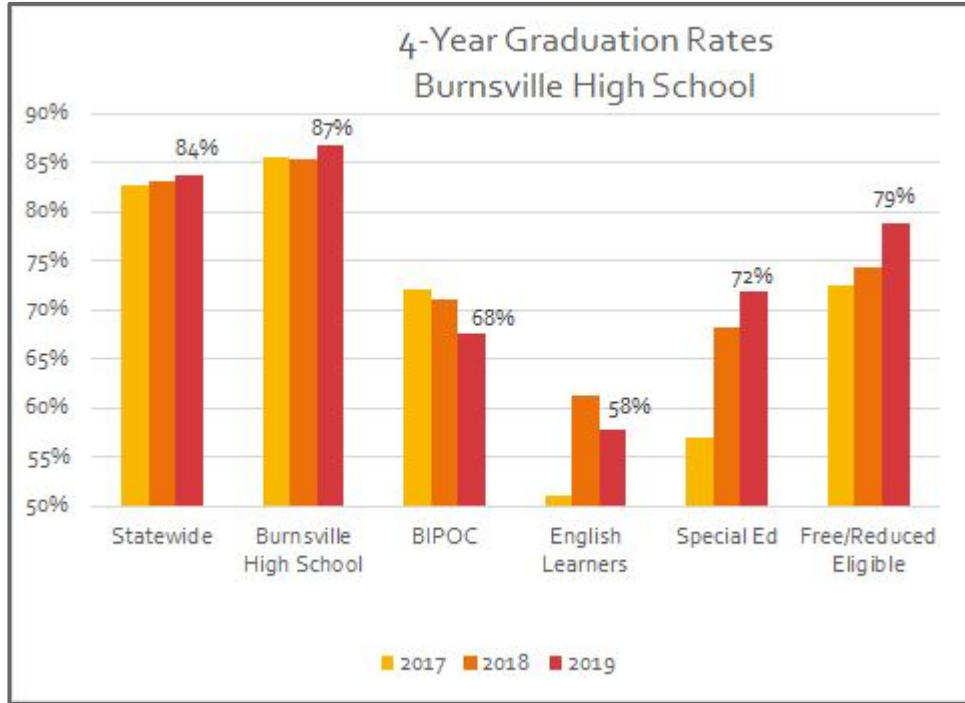
College & Career Readiness

Graduation Rates



2019 World's Best Workforce Goal:
Increase the four-year graduation rate for BHS from 85% in 2018 to 90% in 2019

Results:

2019 four-year graduation rate = 87%

2020 World's Best Workforce Goal:
Increase the four-year graduation rate for BHS from 87% in 2019 to 90% in 2020

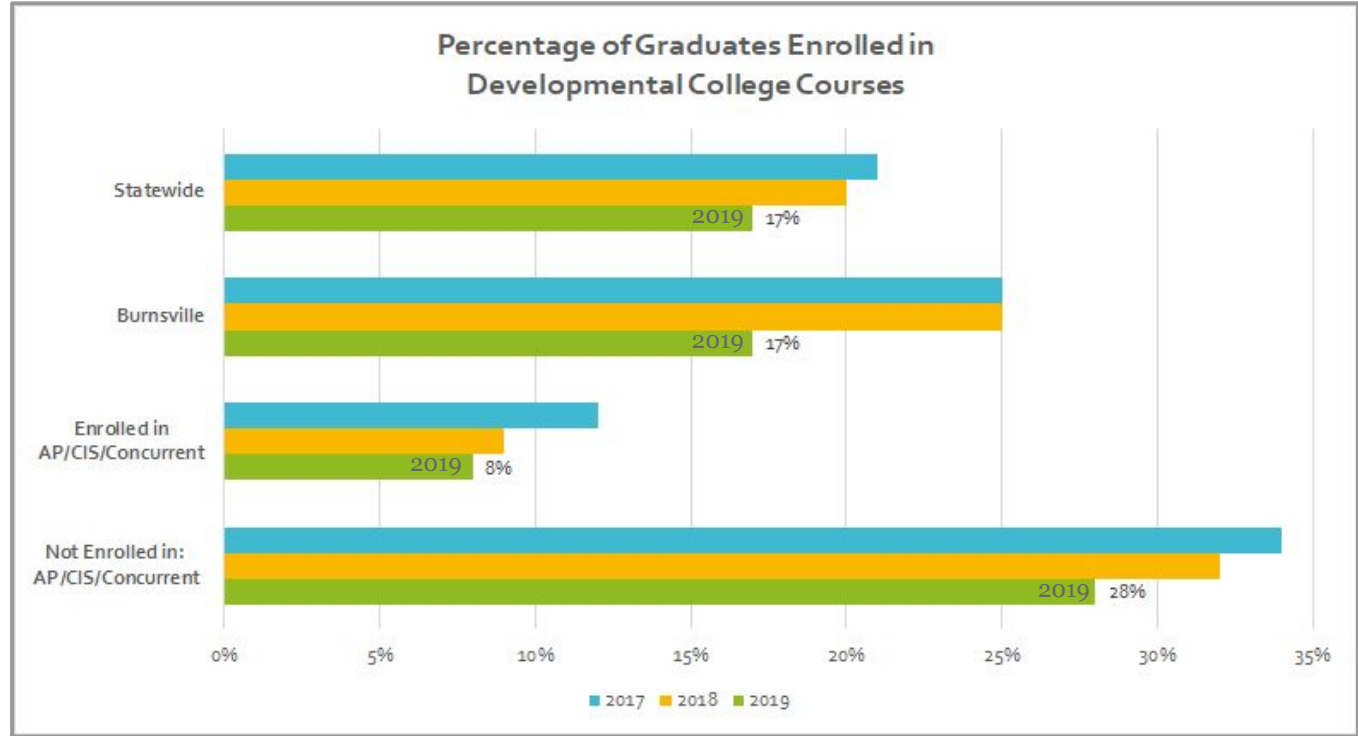
Rigorous Course Enrollment

*Not included are graduates working in another state, enlisted in military service or self-employed.

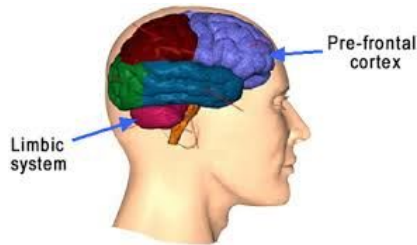
Post Secondary Preparation
