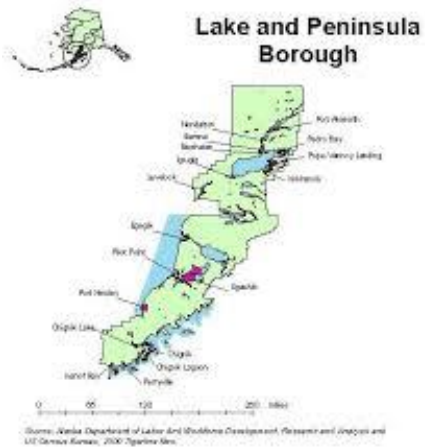

To Whom It May Concern:

As the Superintendent of Lake and Peninsula School District, I am writing you today asking that you please reconsider the dues structure for our School Board. Due to the decline in Federal and State funding, your dues invoice has been tabled for discussion at our next Board Budget Workshop in March.

I would like to ask if you would consider employing a reduced rate for LPSD to belong to AASB. During my tenure with the district, we have faithfully paid our \$10,000 per year dues. However, in recent years, times have changed drastically when it comes to evaluating the worth of our expenditures.

In an effort to cut costs, our Board has already decreased its own spending by limiting travel, reducing the number of times they meet in person throughout the year, and limiting their participation in AASB events. When we do work with AASB, attend conferences, or contract services, we are charged for these services.

I appreciate that you have a structure in place to support your association, but please understand that times have become so tight financially that we are forced to question if the cost is fair and equitable for our district. With our limited involvement in AASB, we ask that you consider a reduced level of membership or some sort of "associate membership" rate.
