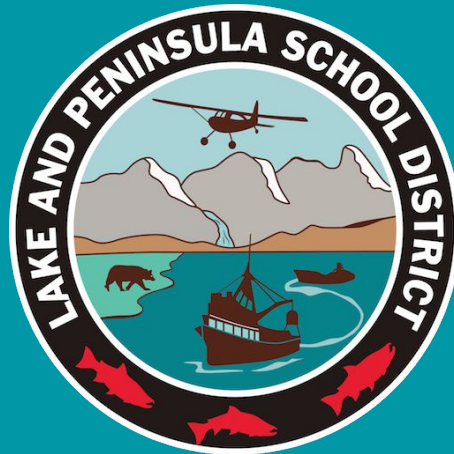

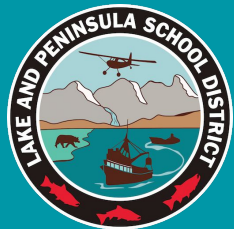


Purpose of Student Services Committee

The Committee evaluates program effectiveness, ensures alignment with district mission and policy, and suggests measures to enhance accessibility, equity, and quality of services.

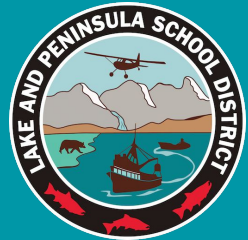
Such recommendations ensure that the District sustains a comprehensive student services program that addresses the diverse needs of students, promotes success in school and beyond, and strengthens connections with families and community partners.

The Student Services Committee regularly identifies areas of student support for in-depth analysis. Such projects may include review of counseling, health and wellness services, evaluating absenteeism, and engagement with partnership entities. Projects are undertaken to address public input, align services with Board policy, and review Administration assumptions and implementation.

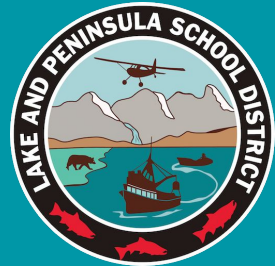

Review of LPSD Student Services

Multi-Tiered System of Support

Intensive, Individualized Interventions

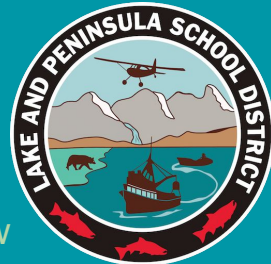
- Individualized, intensive application of protective factors (Sources of Strength)
- Personalized, ongoing counseling and referral to outside resources (in-person & virtual)
- Individualized Education Programs 504 Plan At Risk youth screeners

Targeted Interventions

- Targeted skill-building and peer/mentor supports (Sources of Strength)
- Check-ins or workshops for students needing extra planning or motivation
- Scheduled Counseling for students showing mild to moderate challenges
- Small groups (anxiety, friendship, organization) - 504 Plan
- Intervention screeners for at-risk youth

Universal Strategies - All Students

- Schoolwide culture of strengths and connection (Sources of Strength)
- Strengths & Difficulties Questionnaire (SDQ, 6th grade and up)
- Crisis Prevention Intervention (CPI) - Student Government
- Language & Dance - site based - Attendance Accountability
- Everyday Speech - Social/Emotional Learning - SNAP Meet/Bree & Erin's Law
- Classroom or grade-level lessons on future readiness and academic planning
