Background Information:

Jacksonville Crimson Sports Hall of Fame

The Jacksonville High School Sports Hall of Fame is designed to foster pride and spirit in both the alumni and Jacksonville community. Its purpose is to recognize athletic achievements plus contributions to athletic success from individuals, teams, coaches and contributors. The Hall of Fame provides the opportunity to share athletic history, celebrate the memories, and relive some of the special moments of the past with friends, teammates, and the community.

Candidates may be eligible on the basis of one or more of the following:

1. **IHSA Athletic Accomplishments:** An athlete must have attended and graduated from Jacksonville High School and been out of school for more than five years prior to selection. They must have earned a letter in a sport or sports which the IHSA hosts state final competition for at least two years. In addition, they should have received All-Conference, District, Sectional or State honors. **(Simple Majority?)**
2. **Non-IHSA Athletic Accomplishments:** An athlete must have attended and graduated from Jacksonville High School and been out of school for more than five years prior to selection. They must have demonstrated outstanding athletic performance including some form of objective measurement of success. **(2/3 majority?)**
3. A coach or athletic director must be retired from coaching or left Jacksonville High School and have made a significant impact on the school's athletic program during his or her years of service. **(2/3 majority?)**
4. A contributor (team doctor, administrator, booster, etc.) must have made a significant impact on Jacksonville High School Athletics. **(2/3 majority?)**
5. To be selected the nominee must be of good character. **(? Board Veto)**
6. **Candidates, or an approved delegate if candidate is deceased, must be able to attend the HOF event**

Consideration and voting:

- * Candidates should be nominated based on their impact on JHS athletics during the career, tenure, etc.
- * Nominating forms, including any facts, figures, stats, special honors, contributions or other significant information should be submitted to the JHS Sports Hall of Fame committee for assistance in the selection process.
- * Nomination forms should be submitted prior to the deadline selected by the committee for the upcoming enshrinement.
- * If the person/group nomination does not lead to an induction into the JHS Sports Hall of Fame during the year that person/group is nominated, the nomination form will be kept on file and reviewed by the selection committee for an additional five years.

Online Application:

Nominators should fill out the nomination forms online. The forms are available under the Athletics tab of Jacksonville High web page (www.jsd117.org) or under the local sports tab of WLDS-WEAI's web page (www.wlds.com). Nominators can fill out the form and submit it to any of the committee members, the JHS athletic director's office or to WLDS-WEAI.

RECEPTION OF VISITORS, PETITIONS AND COMMUNICATIONS

(Please note: The Board typically does not respond to comments or questions during this time, it is our time to listen to you. We will take your questions and comments under advisement and, as necessary, may refer them to the administration for appropriate action.)

Board Policy 2:230

Public Participation at Board of Education Meetings and Petitions to the Board

For an overall minimum of 30 minutes during each regular and special open meeting, any person may comment to or ask questions of the Board (public participation), subject to the reasonable constraints established and recorded in this policy's guidelines below. During public participation, there will be a 20-minute minimum total length of time for any one subject. When public participation takes less time than these minimums, it shall end.

To preserve sufficient time for the Board to conduct its business, any person appearing before the Board is expected to follow these guidelines:

1. Address the Board only at the appropriate time as indicated on the agenda and when recognized by the Board President. The Board President may allow extra time according to the topic and wishes of the rest of the members of the Board.
2. Identify oneself (name, address, email) and be brief. Ordinarily, the time for any one person to address the Board during public participation shall be limited to five minutes. In unusual circumstances, and when an individual has made a request to speak for a longer period of time, the person may be allowed to speak for more than five minutes.
3. Observe, when necessary and appropriate, the:
 - a. Shortening of the time for each person to address the Board during public participation to conserve time and give the maximum number of people an opportunity to speak;
 - b. Expansion of the overall minimum of 30 minutes for public participation and/or the 20-minute minimum total length of time for any one subject; and/or
 - c. Determination of procedural matters regarding public participation not otherwise covered in Board policy.
4. Conduct oneself with respect and civility toward others and otherwise abide by Board policy 8:30, Visitors to and Conduct on School Property.

Petitions or written correspondence to the Board shall be presented to the Board in the next regular Board packet.
